SOCI 2011 SDE: Youth and Canadian Society

Youth is complex both in terms of societal discourse on youth and the many transitions an individual will undergo as they move from child to adult in North American society. Addresses the central questions and issues surrounding youth from a sociological perspective. Bodily changes as one moves from child to adult, relationship formations taking on new meaning and often new forms of intimacy, life choices are made, and individuals gain more independence within a cultural milieu that shapes youth. Using a critical perspective, how youth is socially constructed will be examined for its impact on the micro, macro, and meso levels.

SOCI 2112 ADE: Sociology of Culture

An introduction to theory and research on the sociology of culture, the organization and dynamics of cultural systems, cultural production and consumption, subcultures, mass culture, popular culture, and strategies of interpretive analysis for the study of culture.

SOCI 2112 ADG: Sociology of Illicit Drugs

An interdisciplinary examination of the regulation of illicit drugs in Canada from across social science perspectives. The course will provide students with an overview of drug policies historically, including their relationship to, the criminal justice system, settler colonialism and immigration. The course will equip students with an understanding of how the regulation of drugs is embedded across various institutions, and how people who use drugs experience this regulation.

SOCI 2221 SDE: Crime & Society

A study of criminal behaviour; nature and incidence of crime and delinquency; theories of crime causation and prevention; punishment and reform.

A study of the social and cultural dimensions of health and illness. Topics may include: the social organization of medicine; social determinants of health status; lay perspectives on health, illness and the body; the experience of illness and health care; and the impact of social change on medical beliefs and practice.

SOCI 3113 ADE: Activism and Political Scholarship

Through this course, we will develop an understanding of how to conceptualize and conduct activist research with a primary focus on qualitative research methods. We will explore sociological literature on activist scholarship with the specific concern of conducting socially relevant, activist scholarship that is grounded in ethical commitments to community-based groups and marginalized research participants.

SOCI 3114 ADE: Gender and Health

An exploration of gender and health from a critical sociological and intersectional perspective with attention to patterns of health and illness, health behaviours and practices, and the evolving gendered history of health professions and informal care. The role of critical social, feminist and queer theorists in re-framing approaches to sex and gender in health research, policy and education will be explored. Contemporary debates and challenges in the local and global health arena and our place as sociologists within those debates will be discussed.
