

Delivery Method

Lakehead University's AQ, ABQ, HSQ, PQP, and SOQP courses are all delivered asynchronously online using D2L/Brightspace. Some courses contain optional synchronous sessions in order to supplement the asynchronous model. These are conducted through Zoom. For some courses, such as SOQP and PQP, these may be required rather than optional.

Blended delivery may be possible for courses offered in partnership with school boards. If your board is interested in discussing this, please contact us at ag@lakeheadu.ca.

Transferability of Credentials

Our AQ/ABQ/HSQ courses carry **full university degree credit** (1.0 FCE). This means your courses are recognized by teaching governance bodies in other jurisdictions outside of Ontario such as in British Columbia and Alberta.

Accreditation

Instruction and all courses are accredited by the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT) and qualifications earned are submitted for inclusion on your Certificate of Qualification and Registration. Additionally, all courses (except PQP) are recognized as both AQs and university degree credits by both QECO and OSSTF's salary placement evaluation programs as you build your career.

Tuition is \$660 for AQs and \$735 for ABQs and HSQs. This includes a \$10 non-refundable processing fee. PQP I and II tuition is \$950, including a \$150 non-refundable processing fee.

SOQP Modules 1–4 are \$1,350 each, including a \$150 non-refundable processing fee. SOQP Practicum is \$750, non-refundable.


