

Thesis Embargo Form (Optional)

It is the intention of Lakehead University to make our research accessible wherever possible, and so it is procedure to make all student theses and dissertations Open Access in <u>Lakehead Knowledge Commons</u>. Open Access enables scientific advancement, allows for research to be put into practice by those outside academia, and benefits the careers of researchers by improving the recognition of their work¹.

However, we grant exceptions to the immediate release of all theses and dissertations in specific cases. For example, an author may want to delay the release of their thesis in order to submit their work for formal publication in a journal.

The author (student), in consultation with their supervisor and with the approval of the Graduate Coordinator, has the right to postpone public access for a period of up to one year from the date of the student's final thesis submission.

Publication is to be postponed for:

□ 6 months after final thesis submission

□ one year after final thesis submission
