Thunder Bay & Area Victim Services also offers an alternative choice for reporting human trafficking and intimate partner violence to the Police without judgement in order to lessen the impact of victimization.

We provide trauma informed support through short term emotional support, providing referral to wanted services, while providing advocacy and practical assistance to victims affected by crime and tragic circumstances. May also apply for VQRP+ financial assistance.

Victim Quick Response Program+ (VQRP+)

Victim Quick Response Program (VQRP+) provides timely financial assistance to eligible individuals who have been victimized by violent crime and/or their family members as well as witnesses. Requires completion of Consent form and a VQRP+ application. See "VQRP+ program objectives are:" in this pamphlet.

Specific objectives of TBAVS services are:

- Trauma informed immediate crisis line response,
- To accept referrals from police, emergency, community services and self-referrals, as well as on scene support when available,
- To provide short term emotional support,
- > To provide practical support,
- To provide resource information and referrals to the victim,
- To empower the individual who has been victimized to connect with appropriate community resources,
- To provide advocacy for those who are affected by crime,
- To be community engaged,
- To discuss immediate safety planning with the victim,
- To promote victim's rights,
- To adhere to confidentiality and consent,
- > To provide valuable volunteer experiences,
- VQRP+ application to VQRP Ontario for financial assistance if eligible,
 - **Not all incidents are eligible for financial assistance**

Crimes Served

Homicide or attempted Homicide, Human Trafficking, Intimate Partner Violence, Sexual Assault or Distribution of Intimate Images without consent, Elder Abuse, Serious Physical Assault, Historical Child Sexual Abuse, Hate Crimes, and Tragic Circumstances.

VQRP+ program objectives are:

VQRP+ is acquired as last resort and as a result of the immediate crime, to assist individuals who require immediate assistance that cannot be obtained through other sources. These services, as a result of the immediate crime, may include:

Funeral Expenses (not all): for homicide **Home Safety:** to secure premises for victim's safety

Emergency transportation: according to eligibility

Crime Scene Clean-Up: bodily and crime scene investigation fluids

Emergency Accommodation: safe accommodation, basic needs, and meals when eligible

Serious Assault Supports: when eligible, contact TBAVS

Human Trafficking Supports: every situation is different, please contact TBAVS **Cell Phone:** safety phone when eligible

**VQRP+ may have a turnaround approval of up to 3 business days by VQRP+ Ontario. Most financial assistance is paid to VQRP+ approved services required or determined services/needs approved by VQRP+ Ontario, not TBAVS.
