Important Instructions for Applying to Year Three of the Honours Bachelor of Social Work Program:

Please read the following important instructions prior to starting the Supplemental Application package:

1) The Application Process:

IMPORTANT: If you have already graduated with a university degree or are expecting to graduate in the spring from an accredited institution, you are **NOT ELIGIBLE** for the Third Year Honours Bachelor of Social Work program. Please apply to the One-Year Honours Bachelor of Social Work program, using program code ABM.

Applicants Currently Studying at Lakehead University:

Apply using the <u>Lakehead University Undergraduate Application</u>. The deadline to apply is **Friday**, **December 12, 2025**. Late applications will not be accepted.

Log in using your OUAC username and password. Under 'Application Links' select 'Browse Programs', and locate **Year Three of the Honours Bachelor of Social Work** (program code **AAO**) under 'Degree Programs'. Click on the program name to apply.

On the 'Program Details' page, select your intended start date, course load, campus and year level. Note, Lakehead University offers Year Three of the Honours Bachelor of Social Work program at both of its campuses: Thunder Bay and Orillia. If you would like to submit an application to both campuses, you must select each program separately. Selected programs will be added to 'Program Choices'. Your OUAC application fee includes up to three choices.

If you are planning to submit an application to both campuses, make sure that your preferred campus is your number one choice. Note you may be assigned to either campus based on your overall application score.

You must complete this application by the deadline date or your file will be incomplete.

For Applicants Who Are Not Currently Studying at Lakehead University:

Apply using the <u>Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) Undergraduate</u>
<u>Application</u>. The deadline to apply is **Friday**, **December 12**, **2025**. Late applications will not be accepted.

The OUAC Program Code for Year Three of the Honours Bachelor of Social Work program is **AAO**. Click on the *Program Title* link (e.g. Social Work [Thunder Bay & Orillia]). Once on the *Program Details* page, select the campus that you are interested in attending. Lakehead University offers Year Three of the Honours Bachelor of Social Work program at both of its campuses: Thunder Bay and Orillia. If you would like to submit an application to both campuses, you must use two separate application choices. Your OUAC application fee includes two choices. If you are planning to submit an application to both campuses, make sure that your preferred campus is your number one choice. Please note that when applying to both campuses you may be assigned either campus based on your overall application score.

NOTE: Campus assignments are final and non-negotiable.

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Supplemental Application Package Instructions:

2) Transcripts and Academic Records:

<u>For students **NOT** currently registered at Lakehead University</u>: You must submit <u>all</u> secondary and post-secondary transcripts. This includes all high schools, colleges, and universities attended. If you are taking or have taken courses from a post-secondary institution other than your home institution, (e.g. on a Letter of Permission, as a visiting student, or exchange student, etc.) you are required to submit official transcripts from those institutions as well. If you are currently completing courses at a post-secondary institution, you must submit in-progress official transcripts showing your entire course enrolment (i.e. in- progress courses) and grades to date.

Note, <u>final official transcripts</u> that display all final grades must be received by no later than 4:30 PM EST on May 8, 2026.

Current and previous Lakehead University students do not need to re-submit transcripts, unless you have attended an institution after attending Lakehead.

3) Credential Assessments

If you have completed post-secondary studies outside of Canada or the United States, you are required to submit a full course-by-course international credential evaluation from World Education Services (WES) for every post-secondary institution that you have attended. We must receive your results by no later than 4:30 PM EST on May 8, 2026. All associated fees are your responsibility. WES assessments may take several months or longer. Please plan accordingly. WES will inform us when your results are available. We can access your WES results electronically. You do not need to send us a copy of the official transcript(s) that you send WES or a copy of the WES credential evaluation results! WES will send us both.

4) English Language Proficiency (if applicable)

If your first language is not English, you must demonstrate that you are able to meet the language demands of an English language university. All associated fees are your responsibility. To learn more about our English Language Proficiency requirements, please visit: English Language Proficiency Requirements | Lakehead University.

If you are required to submit proof of English language proficiency, this is to be received by no later than 4:30 PM EST on May 8, 2026.

If you are a second year student at Lakehead University, you are not required to submit proof of English language proficiency.

5) Supplemental Application Package

You are required to assemble the following supplemental application package, which contains the following documentation:

- The Supplemental Information Form (Form A)
- A Resume of Your Education, Work and Volunteer Experience
- Special Accommodations Documentation (only if you have indicated you have a diagnosed disability [refer to #10 below for further information])



Supplemental Application Package Instructions:

The School of Social Work must receive your <u>complete</u> Supplemental Application Package and references on or before **Thursday**, **December 18**, **2025**. The School of Social Work will not accept Supplemental Application Packages and references received after December 16th.

You are required to email your supplemental application package to the School of Social Work at social.work@lakeheadu.ca.

6) References

Your choice of references should include individuals who can attest to your potential as a social work student and your demonstrated suitability for social work practice. You are encouraged to seek professional references from individuals who are familiar with your volunteer or social work related activities. **Family members and friends are <u>not</u> suitable references**.

You must submit **two (2) references** to complete your supplemental application package. Refer to **Form B** below. Add your full legal name (<u>must match the name used on your OUAC</u> <u>application</u>) to the form and then forward to your referees to complete. **The referee must email** the completed form to the School of Social Work at <u>social.work@lakeheadu.ca.</u>

The School of Social Work must receive both of your reference forms by Thursday, December 18, 2025. The references received must match the reference information provided on Form A below. To see if the School of Social Work has received both of your reference forms, refer to Required Documents within Admissions under 'My Application' in myServices.

It is your responsibility to ensure that the School of Social Work receives both of your references by the deadline above.

7) Resume of Education, Work and Volunteer Experience

Please outline, in chronological order, your educational achievements, employment experiences and volunteer activities. Identify the position you held and include a brief description of your responsibilities, and the length of time you spent at each work or volunteer site. Additional information, such as extracurricular interests, workshops, seminars, certificates and other educational experiences, including field placements, should also be included. The Admissions Committee considers both depth and variety of Social Work related volunteer experience. Your resume should be no more than **five (5)** pages in length. The resume style and format is of your choice.

8) Submitting Documentation

A) You must submit all transcripts (LU transcripts not required), credential assessments (if applicable), and English language proficiency scores (if applicable) to Recruitment & Admissions by the stated deadline dates.

Copies of your transcripts can be uploaded via myServices using the document upload tool or can be emailed to docs.admission@lakeheadu.ca. Please include your Lakehead University student ID in the subject line of your email. Lastly, you can mail these documents to Recruitment & Admissions using the following address:

You are responsible for ensuring that Recruitment & Admissions receives your transcripts on time. Note, **final official transcripts** will be required should an offer of admission be extended.

9) Admissions

The availability of fieldwork placements, qualified field supervisors, and class size limitations restricts admission to a selected number of individuals to each program annually. To be considered for admission, **you must have:**

- A combined average of at least 70% in: Social Work 1100 Introduction to Social Welfare, Social Work - 2011 Foundations of Social Work Practice, and Social Work 2012 - Human Development; and
- 2. A minimum overall average of at least 70%.
- 3. 10 FCE (Full Course Equivalents) must be completed by the end of August. These shall be comprised of 2 Social Work FCE (SOWK 1100, SOWK 2011, and SOWK 2012) plus 8 FCE Non Social Work electives.
- 4. If applying from another educational facility, a minimum of 3 FCE must be completed at Lakehead University (SOWK 1100*, SOWK 2011 and SOWK 2012 plus 1 additional FCE). If SOWK 1100 is awarded as an Advanced Standing Credit, SOWK 2011, SOWK 2012 plus 2 additional FCE's are required.

Please note that meeting the minimum admission requirements does not guarantee admission.

Admission to the program considers professional and academic suitability determined by the following criteria:

- 1. Academic Record (50%)
- **2. References** (15%)
- 3. Resume indicating Work and Volunteer Experiences (10%)
- **4. Personal Statement** (see details below) (25%)

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Supplemental Application Package Instructions:

10) Personal Statement Exam

Using your student portal, you will be required to complete a personal statement exam online anytime **between 9:00 am on Friday, January 23, 2026 and 5:00 pm on Monday, January 26, 2026**. The School of Social Work will email you further instructions to your Lakehead University email account (myEmail) by January 21, 2026. You are strongly encouraged to access <u>myServices</u> and <u>myEmail</u> well before these dates. If you cannot, <u>recover your account!</u>

If you require special accommodations for your personal statement exam, please indicate this on Form A and include the required documentation indicated on Form A as part of your Supplemental Application Package submission.

For applicants who are current Lakehead University students, please include a copy of your Special Accommodations Form available from Student Accessibility Services. For non-Lakehead University students, please include documentation from your home university/or a qualified practitioner clearly indicating any additional time you require to complete the exam. You are responsible for any costs associated with writing the personal statement exam.

Your Personal Statement Exam consists of a series of essay-styled questions. Your responses will be evaluated on content, personal/professional awareness, and writing ability. The following are examples of questions you may be asked.

- Identify and discuss life experiences that have significantly affected your decision to select social work as a profession.
- How would you describe the role of a professional social worker?
- Reflect on the qualities that you possess that might enhance your practice of social work and those qualities that you would like to develop further in your professional social work training.
- What do you look forward to gaining from the professional years of social work education that will contribute to your professional competence?
- **11)** Lakehead University is committed to creating a diverse and inclusive environment and welcomes Applications from all qualified individuals including Indigenous Peoples, racialized persons, persons with disabilities and other equity seeking groups.

12) Program Deferral Not Available

Students must accept admission to the HBSW program in the calendar year in which it is offered. Admission cannot be deferred to a subsequent year. If a student declines an offer, they must reapply with a full application of required documents in a subsequent year.

13) Admission is offered on a full-time basis. Permission for part time status is very limited and requires the approval of the Admissions Committee and the Director of the School of Social Work.



Supplemental Application Package Checklist:

For non-Lakehead University students - I have sent all of my secondary and post-secondary transcripts to Recruitment & Admissions by the deadline stated in the instructions. I have not included copies of my transcripts with the Supplemental Application Package.
For Applicants with a documented disability that require special accommodations to complete the Personal Statement Exam:
As a Lakehead University student, I have included my Special Accommodations Form supplied by Student Accessibility Services. As a student from another institution, I have included documentation from my home university/or a qualified practitioner clearly indicating any additional time I may require to complete the exam (for non-Lakehead students).
I have completed my full Supplemental Application Package , and have emailed it along with my resume to the School of Social Work by the deadline stated in the instructions.
For Applicants with International Post-Secondary Studies Only: I have made arrangements to have my <u>course-by-course</u> international credential <u>assessment from the World Education Services</u> sent to Recruitment & Admissions by the deadline stated in the instructions.
For Applicants who Require Proof of English Language Proficiency: I have made arrangements to have my official English language proficiency test scores sent to Recruitment & Admissions by the deadline stated in the instructions. If you are a second year student at Lakehead University, you are not required to submit proof of English language proficiency.
For non-Lakehead University Applicants: I received my Acknowledgement Email and I have accessed both myServices and myEmail. I understand that it is my responsibility to access each of these sites. Support can be provided by Student Central.
It is my responsibility to ensure that my references have submitted the reference form (Form B) to the School of Social Work by the deadline date. *Please ensure that your legal name used on your OUAC application is the same name used on your reference forms.
I am prepared to write my Personal Statement Exam online, in a consecutive 3.5-hour timeframe, anytime between 9:00 am on January 24, 2025 and 5:00 pm on January 27, 2025 .
I understand that the School of Social Work will not accept incomplete or late applications.
