SW 4500 (1.5) Field Instruction II  
SW 4212 (.5) Social Policy and Social Welfare  
SW 4411 (.5) Social Work Practice and Indigenous Peoples  
SW 4405 (1) Research in Social Work  
One half-course Elective in Social Work (.5)
