## H.B.S.W. - FOUR YEAR PROGRAM with Major Concentration in Women's Studies

### Year One:

Social Work 1100 (1) Introduction to Social Welfare  
Women's Studies 1100 (1) Women's and Gender Studies  
One FCE in Woman's Studies (1)  
One FCE from Type A (if Women's Studies 1100 counted as Type B) or one FCE from Type B (if Women's Studies 1100 counted as Type A) (1)  
One FCE Elective – Social Work and courses cross-calendared with SW excluded (1)

### Year Two:

SW 2011 (.5) Foundations of Social Work Practice  
SW 2012 (.5) Human Development  
One FCE in Women's Studies Core Courses at the second year level (1)  
One FCE elective in Women's Studies Group 1 at the third year level, excluding WOME 3030 (1)\*  
One FCE elective in Social Work, or in a field relevant to Social Work, approved by the School of Social Work on a case by case basis (1) \*\*  
One FCE Elective - Social Work and courses cross-calendared with SW excluded (1)

**Students must apply to be admitted to the Third Year of the HBSW Four Year Program in January of Year 2 of the HBSW Program.**

### Year Three:

SW 3215 (.5) Social Work Interviewing and Communication Skills I  
SW 3315 (.5) Social Work Interviewing and Communication Skills II  
SW 3401 (1) Theory of Social Work Practice I  
SW 3500 (1.5) Field Instruction I\*\*\*  
WOME 3030 (.5) Theorizing Equality  
One FCE elective in Social Work = two half-course Social Work electives (1)

### Year Four:

SW 4401 (1) Theory of Social Work Practice II  
SW 4500 (1.5) Field Instruction II\*\*\*  
SW 4212 (.5) Social Policy and Social Welfare  
SW 4405 (1) Research in Social Work  
SW 4411 (.5) Social Work Practice and Indigenous Peoples  
One half course elective in Women's Studies Group 1 at the fourth year level (.5)

**\*Students must contact the Women's Studies department for permission to enter third year courses to fulfill second year requirements.**

**\*\*Students must contact the School of Social Work for permission to take third year social work elective courses to fulfill second year requirements.**

**\*\*\*Social Work 3500 and/or 4500 must involve social work practice with women or the LGBTQ+ community**
