NCTS works with an associate team model, hiring independent professionals on contract to deliver essential mental health support services, with a client-centered and community-oriented approach. Our associate model relies on a core of dedicated counsellors who have extensive experience working with northern and Indigenous residents. This core team is augmented by professional consultants who provide extended services as needed.

NCTS develops mental health and wellness programs and services to meet the needs of individuals, groups, communities, businesses, government departments and private sector organizations. Our approach is culturally sensitive and supports the mental wellbeing of community members, employees and families across Northern Canada.

NCTS is currently expanding our team to meet our contract needs for itinerant counsellors (able to travel) in Nunavut, Northwest Territories, and Yukon communities. This work is agency style work, including both short (2 week) critical response services, as well as longer (6-8 week) re-occurring contracts in Arctic communities.
