The course will be team-taught by a variety of core graduate faculty who will offer diverse perspectives on management theory and specific business functions.	<b>Description</b> <del>A one-week</del> <i>This intensive required course serves as the introductory platform for the Master of Business Administration (MBA) program. Specifically, students will be introduced to contemporary theory and practice of successful managers through guest lecturers, case analyses, scholarly readings and team building exercises. The course will be team-taught by a variety of core graduate faculty who will offer diverse perspectives on management theory and specific business functions and professionals; it aims to develop students' confidence in their abilities so that they can succeed in a graduate-level learning environment. During this course students are introduced to key business skills; including but not limited to statistics and quantitative analysis, case study analysis, decision-making, written communication, and team work.</i>
