

NOSM Report to Senate March 2014

At the senate meeting in March 2014, the following was reported verbally:

The recent accreditation visit for our undergraduate medical education program seems to have been a great success.

The accreditation team will submit its report to the full committee of CACMS/LCME. The Dean will have a right of response to correct any factual issues. The preliminary report to the Dean, however, seems to indicate that we have corrected all the outstanding issues identified in our full accreditation visit.

This years' CaRMS match results were also reported on. All but one of our students were matched in the first iteration, with 56% accepting positions in family medicine and 36% positions in the general specialties and 7% in other specialties. 35% of our graduates will be joining one of our residency programs.

Our own residency positions were filled on the first iteration with only 5 exceptions and these positions are expected to fill in the next round, which will contain a large number of international medical graduates, eager to enter postgraduate training in Canada.
