A. CURRICULUM/CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #8-2013 OF OCTOBER 21, 2013, ITEM 5

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on November 21, 2013 to review items that were referred from the October 21, 2013 Senate meeting, and makes the following curriculum recommendations for the 2014-2015 Calendar:
