REPORT OF THE SENATE LIBRARY COMMITTEE

(for approval at the April 14, 2014 meeting of Senate)

The Senate Library Committee met on March 24, 2014. The Librarian's Report provided details of the Library's new liaison program, whereby designated librarians will be assigned to specific academic units to engage with faculty and students and provide enhanced discipline-specific service. It was also reported that the Ontario Council of University Libraries has received funding from the EnAbling Change Fund to undertake a project of research to address the critical issues involved in video captioning. This project will provide recommendations as to how Ontario university libraries will be able to meet the requirement of the AODA to provide accessibility to multi media/digital resources.

The Committee's next scheduled meeting will take place on April 29, 2014.
