NOSM Report to Lakehead University Senate September 2013

This years' entering class of 64 were selected from an applicant pool of 1974. 313 were selected for interview, conducted in both Sudbury and Thunder Bay.

Out of the final 64, 95% (61) are from Northern Ontario and 5% (3) are from the rest of rural and remote Canada.

70% (45) are Female 9% (6) are Aboriginal 20% (13) are Francophone

The average GPA is 3.83

Orientation week has already occurred and was highlighted with visits by the class to Elliot Lake, Mindemoya, M'chigeeng and Manitowaning.

In this academic year NOSM will have its major accreditation visits for postgraduate medicine and a limited site visit for its undergraduate medical education program.

Dr Lisa Graves (UME Associate Dean) has announced her resignation. She will join the Department of Family Medicine in St Michael's Hospital in Toronto as Chief of Department. A search for her replacement is underway. In the interim, her responsibilities will be picked up by other members of the NOSM executive group.
