(b) One FCE in: Geography 2251, Geography 2271, Indigenous Learning 3100, Outdoor Recreation 2510, Psychology 2101, Psychology 3911, Sociology 2911, Sociology 3309
(c) One FCE elective from the following: Anthropology 3010, Anthropology 3115, Anthropology 3118, Anthropology 3811 (with topic title "Arctic Cultures"), Economics 3133, Geography 3311, Geography 3331, Geography 3471, Geology 3130

Fourth Year:

- (a) One and a half FCEs at the fourth year level from Northern Studies Science Electives
- (b) Two FCEs at the third or fourth year level from Northern Studies Science Electives
- (c) Northern Studies 4311
- (d) One FCE elective

Honours Thesis. Students wishing to do an honours thesis (Northern Studies 4901) in the fourth year of the HBSc program must have a faculty advisor by March 1 of their third year and, by March 31, must (a) have a topic approved by the advisor, (b) submit a thesis proposal and (c) provide a preliminary bibliography of at least 20 appropriate references in a format approved by the advisor.
