## Rationale

Currently the Department of Anthropology has a general minor in Anthropology but we have three main streams of Anthropology where a minor would be very attractive to students from other departments. The Department of Anthropology is proposing a Minor in Biological Anthropology for Non-Anthropology Majors. By adding a minor in Biological Anthropology we are able to offer more students the opportunity to receive recognition for the Biological Anthropology courses they have taken by adding a minor to their transcripts without detracting from their program of study or interfering with their major. There is a lot of interest in Biological Anthropology from students in ABMS, Biology, Geography, History and others, and a minor is one way they can demonstrate their formal training in Biological Anthropology. The Minor in Biological Anthropology program focuses on courses of biological anthropology and it provides students the option of taking the biological anthropology courses and introductory courses without having to take both introductory courses in first year. This may be easier for students that have limited electives in their first year and only want to specialize or choose biological anthropology courses.

#### Requirements

- (a) The one required first year course, Anthropology 1032 provide student with an introduction to biological anthropolog

- (c) The required forth year course is a seminar based course that is critical for biological anthropological
