Research & Innovation Weeks 2017

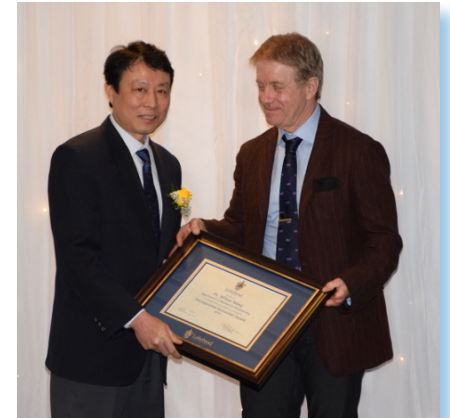
Research & Innovation (R&I) Week 2017 was a tremendous success at both our campuses.

Decades-long contamination of the Wabigoon-English River system in the Kenora area has been an ongoing environmental and medical concern for the nearby First Nation communities, but high levels of mercury is an issue that impacts more than any one place, researchers say.

Lakehead will host a sustainability roundtable that is open to the public entitled, *What Can We Do About Mercury in Our Water?*, and is set for Monday, March 6, from 7-9 p.m., at the Thunder Bay Art Gallery.
