Subject: Senate Research Committee Annual Report 2016/17

I am pleased to submit the 2016-2017 Annual Report on behalf of the Senate Research Committee (SRC). Please note that this Annual Report is being submitted in September since the SRC's work had not wrapped up before the last Senate meeting in the spring. On behalf of Connie Russell, the 2016/2017 SRC Chair, I would like to thank the SRC committee members for their work, particularly those on the Working Group and the Tri-Council Sub-Committees. Below are the highlights of the work undertaken in the 2016/2017 academic year.

Terms of Reference

The SRC worked on its Terms of Reference over the year in consultation with the Senate Organization Committee. The revised document was submitted to Senate Organization in May 2017 and will be reviewed by that committee in the fall.

Sub-Committee Reorganization

Historically, the SRC had two sub-committees (NSERC and SSHRC) for reviewing applications (e.g., Research Development Fund, Publication Assistance, Visiting Scholar Grant). In 2014, the SRC's structure was changed to ensure equitable Tri-Council representation by adding CIHR members to the SRC and dividing CIHR applications between the two existing subcommittees: NSERC/CIHR and SSHRC/CIHR. After evaluating the efficacy of this structure, the SRC agreed to move to three subcommittees (CIHR, NSERC, SSHRC) to further improve the reviewing process and ease subcommittee workload. The first applications adjudicated in this way were the spring conference travel grants. The SRC will monitor the efficacy of this structure over the next few years.

New Centre

The SRC recommended that the proposal for the new Centre for Innovation and Entrepreneurship Research (CIER) be approved.
