Subject: Senate Teaching and Learning Committee Report

The Senate Teaching and Learning Committee (STLC) met on October 15.

Douglas Ivison was acclaimed as Chair for 2018-19.

The Committee appointed faculty members to fill vacancies on its sub-committees.

The Committee approved amendments to its Terms of Reference, including the creation of the position of Vice-Chair.

The Learning Spaces and Technology sub-committee sought feedback on whether to continue assessing classrooms using the Learning Space Rating System (LSRS). STLC noted the value of such assessments for inventorying classroom technology and space, and recommended that, after some adjustments to the LSRS criteria, the assessments continue.

The Writing and Communication sub-committee reported on plans for the National Day of Writing on Friday, October 19, including a series of writing-related activities on the first floor of the Chancellor Paterson Library.
