Failed Year (a) A student is deemed to have failed the year if: (i) the student has failed more than two full courses or their equivalent; or (ii) the student has failed more than one full course or equivalent with marks of less than 40%; or (iii) the student attains an overall average of less than 50% in all courses; or (iv) the student has a failure of more than one full course or its equivalent after special examinations have been given, whether the student writes them or not. (b) In a failed year, course credit is retained for only those courses in which a minimum mark of 60% has been attained. (c) A student having failed no more than one full course (or its equivalent) of the year's</p>	<p>Deleted.</p>

work after special examinations will be permitted to register for the succeeding year of the program.

(d) A student who has failed a year is eligible to apply for re-admission to the University. A student will normally be granted the privilege of repeating one year only.
