## **Removing and Reinstating Courses Policy**

Resolved that the following actions be taken:

1. Each academic unit will indicate which courses will not be offered during the fall/winter sessions and these will be noted as not offered this year.

- **2.1.** Procedure for removing and reinstating courses from the Calendar:
- a) If a course has not been offered for five years, the course (excluding graduate and special topics courses) will be automatically removed from the calendar.
- b) An academic unit wishing to reactivate a course which has been removed from the calendar, in order that it may be time-tabled and re-calendared may do so by applying to the Faculty Dean who will advise the Registrar if the request to reactivate the course has been approved.
