**Spotlight Presentation:** Claude E. Garton Herbarium Highlights and Community Impact (Kristi Dysievick)

The Board received a presentation that focused on the Herbarium, which houses a scientific collection of over 115,000 plant specimens, functioning as a key resource and botanical record, primarily for Northwest Ontario. Its operations are concentrated on three pillars: Preservation, Research, and Education and Outreach. The herbarium's strategic priorities for the coming years include: expanding Community and Indigenous Partnerships, advancing Digitization and Data Sharing, developing comprehensive Funding and Sustainability Plans, and growing Public Programming.
