Spotlight Presentation: Ecuador Partnership Project with the University of Casa Grande (Dr. Mastrangelo - Professor, Lakehead University)

Dr. Mastrangelo's presentation highlighted the research partnership in Guayaquil, Ecuador, with Lakehead University, Casa Grande University, the MEHrit Centre, and A.S.K.

Researchers from Casa Grande University recognized the escalation in youth crime and school drop-out rates in the region and how enhancing knowledge and understanding about self-regulation could be of great benefit to Ecuadorian children and youth.

Through this partnership, researchers began to teach educators about the far-reaching positive contributions of a self-regulation framework on their well-being and the well-being of their students. The Board of Governors expressed their appreciation for the presentation and gained valuable insights into this important research.

 In August 2024, the Ministry of Colleges and Universities (MCU) issued a directive requiring
 publicly funded colleges and universities to inform students of the costs of both mandatory and
 optional textbooks and learning materials in course syllabi. This directive, effective for courses
 starting in January 2025, mandates an annual report to the Board of Governors on compliance,
 including the communication method and plans to ensure full compliance. After Board approval,
 the University must report compliance to the MCU. The Administration reported a 95%
 compliance rate.
