



Arthur V. Mauro (Chancellor, 2009-2012)

Prominent lawyer and businessman, Dr. Arthur V. Mauro, OC, OM, was Lakehead University's 7th Chancellor. Born on February 15, 1927 in Thunder Bay, Ontario, Dr. Mauro studied law at the University of Manitoba and was called to the Bar of Manitoba in 1953. Until 1969 he practiced law, specializing in transportation and communication law.

Dr. Mauro has had an illustrious career. In 1967, he was appointed Chairman of the Royal Commission on Northern Transportation, and in 1969 became a senior executive with Great Northern Capital Corporation. From 1972 to 1976, he was President and Chief Executive Officer of Transair Limited, and joined the Investors Group in 1976 to become its President, Chief Executive Officer, and Chairman. He served as Chancellor of the University of Manitoba from 1991 to 2000 and is currently Chair of the Winnipeg Airport Authority.

Dr. Mauro received an Honorary Doctor of Commerce degree from Lakehead University in 1997. In 1987, Dr. Mauro was made a Member of the Order of Canada and was later promoted to Officer in 1992. In 2004 he was awarded the Order of Manitoba.
