GMAT or GRE scores are one of the requirements for admission into our MBA and MSc. (Mgmt) programs. In August 2011, the GRE revised General Test replaced the GRE® General Test. While the basic component of the test remain the same, there has been significant changes to scales and contents of the test bringing it closer to the requirement of business schools. To facilitate transition, GRE administration has made available tools which calculate equivalency to the previous scales. This calendar change accommodates changes to GRE Test score without changes to our existing admission policy.
