MA Clinical Psychology (Specialization in Women’s Studies)

or MSc Psychological Science (Specialization in Women’s Studies)

Students in the Clinical Psychology or Psychological Science Master’s programs may apply for acceptance into the Collaborative Program with Specialization in Women’s Studies. They would take the Women’s Studies Core Course 5101 (full course) in place of a full course Psychology elective. ~~(Therefore, Psychological Science MSc students would be required to complete 5.5 full course equivalents.)~~ Students would also do a Master’s thesis in the area of Women’s Studies.
