Description of proposed Calendar Change:

College transfer program between 3 year Environmental Technology diploma of Georgian College and HBASc Environmental Sustainability program at department of Interdisciplinary Studies, Lakehead University Orillia.

Rationale of Proposed Calendar Change(s):

Georgian college and Lakehead University signed a memorandum of understanding last June agreeing to the following initiatives: Integrated Diploma/Degree program, the development of "Course to Course" credits, and block transfers.

Through this calendar change, a college transfer program between Georgian College (Environmental Technology major) and Lakehead University (Environmental Sustainability major) is proposed. After the curriculum mapping between these two programs, a maximum of 9 FCEs is proposed to be credited towards HBASc Environmental Sustainability. This articulation will result in better student enrolment for this program in future years. This transfer program will help the students to complete the degree within two years with an additional spring/summer session as described below.

Honours BSc (Environmental Sustainability Major) College Pathway Program

Graduates of a 3-year Environmental Technology Diploma Program from Georgian College may be admitted to the HBASc Environmental Sustainability Program if they have a minimum average of 70%. They are eligible to be credited with a maximum of 9 FCEs towards the HBASc Environmental Sustainability Major, reducing the remaining requirements for the HBASc degree to a maximum of 11 FCEs (with an overall average of 70%), as outlined below. Meeting the minimum requirement does not guarantee admission to either the University or a specific program.


