Rationale of the Proposed Calendar Change(s):

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The designation "Inquiry" and code letter prefix "INQU" used for courses in the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies are relics that date back to 2006 when there were just two courses on the subject of inquiry but no department as such. Since then, the department has come into existence and has proposed other interdisciplinary courses. In other disciplines course designations and codes match the name of the department in which they are offered. We are not a Department of Inquiry -- rather, we are a Department of Interdisciplinary Studies.
