**Report of the Senate Undergraduate Scholarships and Bursaries Committee on Awards: Athletic Awards Policy of January 23, 1984 and Student Integrated Accessibility Regulations**  
(Referral Item #13 of October 19, 2012 Senate Meeting)

**Date of Discussion:** Senate Undergraduate Scholarships and Bursaries Committee Meeting Friday, November 16, 2012

**Rationale for Rescinding the Athletic Awards Policy:**

The information in the Awards: Athletic Awards Policy of January 23, 1984 is no longer correct.

Athletic Awards can be awarded to students who are not considered full-time by the University and students do not have to continue in the same program they were in the previous year. Recipients do not have to attain a 60% average; they must attain a 70% average or higher according to requirements of Canadian University Sport and Ontario University Athletics. Athletic Awards are not limited to \$1000 but can be up to the value of tuition.

**Motion # 3.3**

P. Bosnick stated that Senate requested a review of a Senate regulation dated 1984 regarding Athletic Awards. Since the information is no longer relevant, it is recommended that the regulation be rescinded.

**Motion #7**

To rescind the Awards: Athletic Awards Policy dated January 23, 1984 as it is no longer relevant and does not comply with the Integrated Accessibility Standards Regulation and to consider if changes are required when a review of the Terms and Conditions of Scholarships, Awards and Bursaries is made.
