### A. CALENDAR CHANGES REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #4-2012 OF APRIL 13, 2012, ITEM 4

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on May 3, 2012 to review items for the 2013-2014 academic cycle, referred from the April 13, 2012 Senate meeting and makes the following recommendations:

**(a) Addition of New Course Philosophy 3XXX Philosophy and Psychoanalytical Theory (2013-2014)**

The Committee recommends approval of the new course, Philosophy 3712 – Philosophy and Psychoanalytic Theory.

**(b) Deletion of the following history courses 1. HIST 2751; 2. HIST 4750 (2013-2014)**

The Committee recommends the deletion of the courses, History 2751 and 4750.

**(c) Addition of New Course Philosophy (2013-2014)**

The Committee recommends that Senate approve the new course with Philosophy with one revision and an addition. The course number should be revised to Philosophy 3514 (instead of 3713) and an associated program change should be made. In the Minor Program in Professional Ethics, Philosophy 3514 should be added to the third-year courses in (c):

- (c) One FCE from the following list of third year courses:
- Philosophy 3312 – Philosophy of Law
  - Philosophy 3513 – Professional Ethics
  - Philosophy 3514 - Cyberethics
