Proficiency in the English Language

Applicants whose native language is not English and who have not studied in an English language school system for more than three full years will be required to present proof of English facility:

1. by achieving appropriate standing on one of the following tests:

(a) test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) – minimum acceptable score is 550 (paper-based) or 213 (computer-based);

(b)Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB) - minimum acceptable score is 90;

(c)Canadian Academic English Language (CAEL) Assessment
