Subject: Senate Teaching and Learning Committee Report

The Senate Teaching and Learning Committee (STLC) met on June 17:

- The Learning Spaces and Technology subcommittee reported that RC 1001 will be renovated over the summer to transform it into an active classroom.
- The Teaching Awards subcommittee presented its recommendation for the 2018-19
 Distinguished Instructor Award. STLC endorsed the recommendation and
 forwarded it to the Provost and Vice-President (Academic) for approval.
- STLC recommended that Senate approve the creation of a Teaching Support Award and the associated policy (see attached).
- The Past Exam Policy Review subcommittee submitted its report, which did not recommend changes to the existing policy but noted that there needed to be improvements in the implementation of the policy. In particular, instructors need to be made aware of the policy, and the system needs to be improved so the policy is consistently observed for exams held in Orillia and through D2L. A working group will be struck to discuss how to improve awareness and compliance.
- A draft description of a Lakehead University Teaching Chair program was discussed.
- STLC approved the Terms of Reference for a subcommittee to review the Senate policy on Student Feedback on Teaching. The subcommittee is expected to report back to STLC in Winter 2020.
- STLC reviewed the 2018-19 Annual Report to Senate.
- Dr. Douglas Ivison was acclaimed as Chair for 2019-20 and Dr. Donald Henne as Vice-Chair.
