The mention of the online method of delivery is necessary so that in advance of registering students are aware that this course is not offered in a conventional classroom setting, but rather is an online course. The effect is likely to be positive overall in that students whose schedules are tight will feel comfortable with the asynchronous delivery. This method of delivery facilitates its being taken by Concurrent Education students on the Orillia campus.


