## Senate Undergraduate Scholarships and Bursaries Committee Summary Report to Senate - December 5, 2008

This report provides data with respect to undergraduate students who have received scholarships, awards bursaries and/or OSAP to date for this academic year (2008-2009). A brief overview and some interpretation of the data supplied follows:

## Highlights

Reduction in Budget

- The Lakehead University undergraduate scholarship/award budget decreased to $\$ 1,363,638$ in 2008-2009 from $\$ 1,549,868$ in 2007-2008. The $\$ 1,363,638$ included a carry forward of $\$ 48,274$ from the 2007-2008 budget. As indicated in last year's Senate Report, without budget increases, scholarship disbursements would have to be prioritized or adjusted to reflect budget constraints.

As a result, there are currently no Transfer Scholarships, or In-Course Scholarships funded from Lakehead University scholarship funds. As well, Lakehead University funds for Athletic Scholarships and Awards were reduced by $20 \%$.

There may be a small surplus this year that the Committee can address

## Entrance

- There are 412 entrance scholars this year compared to 433 in 2007-2008. This is $44.06 \%$ of the entering class compared to $45.8 \%$ last year. The number students receiving Lakehead University Entrance Awards ( $75 \%$ to 79.9 \% ) is 225 compared to 246.
- There are 7 students accepting the Lakehead University Northwestern Ontario Leaders' Scholarship compared to a high of 10 students last year. It is interesting to note that we have 1 student from a Thunder Bay High School compared to 6 from Thunder Bay last year.

In-Course

- There is a $4 \%$ increase in students receiving OSAP this year compared to last year. This may be attributed to numerous job losses in the economy.

b) The percentage of entrance scholars from the entering high school class is about the same as last year at 44.06\% this year compared to 45.8\% in 2007-2008.


## 2. IN-COURSE SCHOLARSHIPS

In-Course Scholarships and Transfer Scholarships
For budget reasons, no Lakehead University scholarship funds were available for InCourse Scholarships or Transfer Scholarships in 2008-2009.

The In-Course Scholarship Application was available to students in early February 2008. If funds had remained available 139 students would have qualified for an In-Course Scholarship.

The Transfer Scholarship Application was also available to students before budget cuts were announced. If funds had remained available 52 students would have qualified for a Transfer Scholarship.

## 3. ONTARIO STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ( OSAP )

The overall number of students on OSAP has increased from 2,102 last year to 2,132 this year, a $1.4 \%$ increase and there was a decrease in funding of $0.3 \%$ from \$21,575,382 last year (2007-2008) to \$21,493,673 (2008-2009).
