A. ITEMS REFERRED FROM SENATE MEETING #2008-8 OF NOVEMBER 7, 2008

The Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee met on January 27, March 3, and March 17, 2009 to review the previously deferred calendar change referred from Senate Meeting #2008-8 of November 7, 2008, item 5 and makes the following recommendation:

1. Faculty of Business Administration

(a) Administrative Studies Major – Honours Bachelor of Commerce

The Committee recommends approval of the Honours Bachelor of Commerce (Administrative Studies Major) degree program to be offered exclusively on the Orillia campus, with the exception of the course, Business 3310 – Administrative Studies Orientation, which will have to be resubmitted to Senate for examination. For information purposes, an equivalencies chart (Attachment 1) is being included in this report.

A number of items from previous meetings remain outstanding:() the Modular Curriculum (referred at the May 20, 2008 Senate meeting); the Business Minor – Minimum course mark (referred at the June 13' 2008 Senate meeting); HBSc Applied Bio-Molecular Science (item 3 –four-year BSc), Aboriginal Education, and Sociology – Add Critical Inquiry (referred at the December 5' 2008 Senate meeting); Gerontology Minor and Education 1572 (referred at the January 23, 2009 Senate meeting).

In addition, the Committee deferred the items referred at the February 27th Senate meeting: Forestry 1110 & 1330, Engineering Regulation #8 – probation, and Civil Engineering.
