1. Calculation of Kinesiology average for graduation			
Rationale of the Proposed Calendar Change(s): (Corresponding to Section 2 where required)  1			
Currently the calculation of the kinesiology average is only indicated for continuation in the kinesiology program. It does not actually state anywhere that a 70% Kinesiology average is required for graduation. Additions suggested below clarify the requirement for graduation AND the determination of the average to be based only on kine courses counted toward the degree. Changes need to be made in the sections describing the HBK program and the HBK Co-op Program. No change required for ConEd Kine as students must complete HBK requirements prior to year 5 of ConEd Kine.
