MScF The MScF program requirements include two full course equivalents, a research thesis (worth two and one-half full course equivalents), and the half-course Graduate Seminar (Forestry 5995), for a total of 5 FCEs. The thesis, when deemed ready by the Supervisor and Advisory Committee, is examined externally (administered by the Office of Graduate and International Studies). When the external examination has been satisfactorily completed, the student must defend the thesis in a public oral presentation and examination. The Examining Committee at the defence normally consists of the Supervisor and Advisory Committee. The minimum residency requirement for the MScF program is one academic year.	MScF The MScF program requirements include one and one-half full course equivalents, a research thesis (worth two and one-half full course equivalents), and the two half-course Research Methods I (Forestry 5510) and Research Planning (Forestry 5995), for a total of 5 FCEs. In addition, students must offer their research as a presentation in the Forestry Seminar Series, before the thesis is examined. The thesis, when deemed ready by the Supervisor and Advisory Committee, is examined externally. When the external examination has been satisfactorily completed, the student must present the thesis in a public oral presentation followed by an examination before an Examining Committee normally consisting of the Supervisor and Advisory Committee. The minimum residency requirement for the MScF program is one academic year.
