Nominations for Senate Representative on the Board of Governors

Senate is to recommend to the Board of Governors two faculty senators to serve on the Board of Governors. The following terms are available:

- One Senate representative is required for a three-year term from September 2009 and ending with its Annual Meeting in the fall of 2012;
- One Senate representative is required for two-year term from September 2009 and ending with its Annual Meeting in the fall of 2011.

The continuing Senate representative on the Board is Dr. J. Leggatt.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING ELIGIBILITY CLAUSES:

Eligible to Nominate and Vote: Full-Time Faculty who are currently members of the Board of Governors are NOT eligible to nominate and vote. The following, therefore are NOT eligible to nominate or vote: Dr. J. Leggatt.

Eligible to be Nominated and Elected: Those Senators who are full-time faculty members, who have been members of Senate for the past year, who will be Senators in 2009/2010 and who are not continuing members of the Board of Governors, are eligible to be nominated and elected.
