Section 1

Description of the Proposed Calendar Change:

The following calendar changes are proposed for women's studies: a) changing the required courses at the second year level so that WS2112 remains required but the previously required course WS2711 is now listed among other second-year options offered by the Women's Studies Department - this affects the BA, HBA and the joint programs; b) changing the title of WS4113 and cross-listing it to English; c) adding a course under its own title that has previously been offered under the special topics title; d) revising the title and opening up the restrictions on WS4010; and e) revising the description of the 3rd year special topics course WS3111.

Rationale of the Proposed Calendar Change(s):

(Corresponding to Section 2 where required)

These changes allow for more rotation among the Women's Studies course offerings and also opens up previously restricted courses so that students annually have a greater variety of courses from which to select. Cross-listing courses also increase the variety of course offerings available to students in other programs. These changes are intended to increase class enrolments, provide greater service to other programs, and also provide Women's Studies core faculty with the opportunity to teach more of the calendared courses. There are no budgetary implications for any of these changes.
