In conjunction with the upcoming OCGS review the Psychology Department after an extensive review voted to renew (April 21, 2009) the following adjunct appointments:

Dr. J. M. Haggarty
Dr. L. Maxfield
Dr. F. R. Schmidt

Dr.s Haggarty and Maxfield were previously appointed from Apr. 22, 2005 to June 30, 2008 at the April 1, 2005 meeting of Senate, but we only realized that their term was finished earlier this term when we were advised that the terms were coming to an end for Dr. Schmidt, was appointed from Nov. 25, 2005 to June 30, 2009 at the November 25, 2005 meeting of Senate.

We are requesting four-year terms backdated to July 1, 2009.
