Description of the Proposed Calendar Change:

Acknowledges exceptions in required practicum hours in accommodation to a disability. Currently, in rare cases where students require additional training (e.g., accommodation of a disability, completion of an intervention or assessment, or to ensure competency and readiness for internship), it is difficult for the university to justify extend insurance/liability coverage to student on practicum beyond the prescribed number of hours (i.e., 400 MA hours; 600 PhD hours).
