Revision to Regulation I(n)

Current Regulation:

(n) Courses that are cross-calendared can only be counted towards one of the respective majors.

With the implementation of the *Academic Plan 2006* and the discussion around minors (Section I.B.1.a(4)), it was determined by the Senate Undergraduate Studies Committee that Regulation I(n) should be revised to clarify the use of cross-listed courses between majors and minors in addition to the current reference of two or more majors.

Therefore, a revision of the regulation was brought to Senate and referred to the Senate Academic Regulations Subcommittee for review.

Proposed Revised Regulation:

(n) Courses that are cross-calendared can only be counted towards one of the respective majors or one minor.

PLEASE NOTE:

This regulation is only in reference to CROSS-CALENDARED courses, not ALL courses. Discussion and regulations around 'double-counting' of credits have yet to be developed.
