**Subject:** COURSES NOT OFFERED FOR LAST FIVE YEARS

The review of courses not offered for the last five years has been carried out in consultation with the Deans and affected academic units, as described in the Senate Calendar policy on Removing and Reinstating Courses, as revised by Senate on September 29, 2000, October 26, 2001, January 25, 2002, January 31, 2003, and April 28, 2003. The courses on the attached list have not been offered for the past five years, and according to the revised Senate policy, will be deleted from the 2010-2011 calendar. These include courses that were timetabled, but subsequently cancelled or had no registrants, and courses that were reactivated during this period but were not timetabled and/or still had no registrants. Special topics, co-op work terms, music performance or graduate courses are not included.

(This information should not be confused with the yearly calendar request for Courses Not Offered, where the notation "NOT OFFERED THIS YEAR" is normally added below the course description of courses that will not be timetabled for the fall and/or winter terms.)

As per Senate policy, an academic unit later wishing to reactivate one of these courses that has been removed from the calendar, in order that it may be timetabled and re-calendared, may do so by sending the request to the Dean who will notify the Registrar in a timely manner of requests that were approved.
