Description of the Proposed Calendar Change:

New Course in Young Adult Fiction

Rationale of the Proposed Calendar Change(s):

Rationale:

Young Adult literature, a category which accounts for a significant portion of the books currently published, does not have a clear course in which it can be taught, as other literature courses focus heavily on literature aimed at adults, and Children Literature courses generally focus on texts for a younger readership. Young Adult literature represents a wide variety of genres, and a diverse and global authorship and readership. As such, this course could be taught by a number of different faculty and full-time faculty members. Finally, while this course would be attractive to a significant portion of our students, it would be very useful for our Con-Ed students, particularly those who are in the Junior-Intermediate and Intermediate-Senior Specializations.

Budgetary Implications:

None. The course will replace English 3915: Contemporary Children Literature in regular on-campus rotation. The department has in principle approved Dr. Gellert's development of English 3915: Contemporary Children Literature as a distance-ed course, so we are not deleting it from the calendar at this time.




