Description of the Proposed Calendar Change:

Program Change to HBA English and French

Rationale of the Proposed Calendar Change(s):

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Rationale:

These changes will allow students to take the HBA in English and French concurrently with the BEd degree, and allow all students in the program to take some electives after their first year. The first year Group I requirement was redundant, as the English and French courses in the major cover the Faculty requirement for 2 different Humanities courses. These changes will bring this joint degree in line with other joint Honours degrees, which usually have a 7/8 or 7/7 split between disciplines. The changes to the French courses at the second year level reflect changes in the French curriculum that had not yet been reflected in this degree.

Budgetary Implications:

None, although it will make the degree more appealing to students as it will now allow more room for electives.

Honours BA (English and French)

Four Year program  
A student may enter the Honours BA program in English and French after the first year, with an overall B average in English and French. An overall B average must be maintained in the courses of English and French throughout the program.

First Year:

- (a) English 1111 and 1112
- (b) French 1200 or 1204
- (c) One additional FCE from Group I (see Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities Regulations, First Year Arts Program Grouping Requirements)
- (d) Two FCEs from Group II (see First Year Arts Program Grouping Requirements)

Note:  
English 1111 and English 1112 may be taken in either order.

Second Year:

- (a) English 2903
- (b) One additional FCE in English at the second year level
- (c) One FCE in English (English 1074, 1238 and 1807 do not count for purposes of fulfilling this requirement.)
- (d) French 2201
- (e) One FCE from: French 2420, 2611, 2615, 2801

Third Year:

- (a) Two FCEs in English at the third-year level
- (b) Three FCEs in French at the third or fourth-year level

Fourth Year:

- (a) One FCE in English at the fourth year level
- (b) Two FCEs in English at the third or fourth-year level
- (c) Two FCEs in French at the third or fourth-year level

Proposed Entry

Honours BA (English and French)

Four Year program  
A student may enter the Honours BA program in English and French in the first year, with an overall B average in English and French. An overall B average must be maintained in the courses of English and French throughout the program.

First Year:

- (a) English 1111 and 1112
- (b) French 1200 or 1204
- (c) Two FCEs from Group II (see First Year Arts Program Grouping Requirements)
- (d) 1FCE elective

English 1111 and English 1112 may be taken in either order.

Second Year:

- (a) English 2903
- (b) One additional FCE in English at the second year level
- (c) French 2201
- (d) One additional FCE in French at the second year level
- (e) One FCE elective

Third Year:

- (a) Two FCEs in English at the third-year level
- (b) Three FCEs in French at the third or fourth-year level

Fourth Year:

- (a) One FCE in English at the fourth year level
- (b) One FCE in English at the third or fourth-year level
- (c) Two FCEs in French at the third or fourth-year level
