Course titles should be changed to reflect the Ministry and OCT documents.

The Academic Regulations with respect to probation be altered to reflect the fact that Concurrent Education students on academic probation have been permitted to continue to register in Education courses appropriate to the Honours and General streams. Unless students can continue to take Fall and Winter Term Education courses, they inevitably fall behind, even if they make up academic deficiencies in Spring/Summer Term.

When an Honours concurrent Education student drops down to a BEd, he or she has often acquired 0.5 FCE credits from these Honours stream courses: Edu 4412, 4413, 4416, 4417, and 4418. If such a student cannot utilize these credits towards the 15.0 FCEs required of BEds to enter the Professional Year at the end of the third year, the student would have to take the 1.5 FCEs associated with the non-Honours pathway (Edu 1499, 2399, and 2 x 0.25 FCE Education electives). Accordingly, a student who changes from Honours BEd to BEd will be permitted to utilize up to 2.0 FCE of Education credits previously acquired.

EDUC 4018: "Curriculum and Instruction in Physical and Health Education (Primary-Junior)"

An examination of the Ontario Ministry of Education Documents along with the methods and techniques used in teaching physical and health education in the primary and junior grades.

EDUC 4218: "Curriculum and Instruction in Intermediate Physical and Health Education"

An examination of the Ontario Ministry of Education Documents along with the methods and techniques used in teaching physical and health education in the Intermediate grades.

EDUC 4245: "Curriculum and Instruction in Physical and Health Education"

This course examines the organization and administration of the physical and health education program at the Intermediate and Senior levels with special emphasis on methods, curriculum building using Ministry of Education documents, evaluation and reporting to parents.

EDUC 4018: "Curriculum and Instruction in Health and Physical Education (Primary-Junior)"

This course provides a critical examination of the Ontario Ministry of Education Documents and the methods and techniques used in teaching primary and junior health and physical education.

EDUC 4218: "Curriculum and Instruction in Intermediate Health and Physical Education"

This course provides a critical study of health and physical education programming at the Intermediate level with reference to the Ministry of Education Documents.

EDUC 4245: "Curriculum and Instruction in Health and Physical Education (Intermediate-Senior)"

This course provides a critical study of health and physical education programming at the Intermediate and Senior levels with reference to the Ministry of Education Documents.

- b) A concurrent education student must maintain a minimum cumulative average of 65%.
- c) Students who fail to attain the 65% cumulative average may continue "On Probation" for one year.
- d) Students on probation are not eligible to take Education courses.

c) Primary-Junior students are required to demonstrate mathematics proficiency in conjunction with the Mathematics methods courses, Education 4050 (Curriculum and Instruction in Mathematics, Primary-Junior), taken in the Professional Year. PJ students must pass, to a 75% level of competence, an examination set at the Ontario Gr. 6/7 level. Students who do not pass the initial sitting in the fall may retake the test the following March. Students who do not pass the Mathematics Content examination in March will not be recommended for teacher certification in the Province of Ontario. 
