Section 1

Description of the Proposed Calendar Change:

It is proposed that courses offered by the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies be designated more precisely. Several four-letter codes are to be assigned to courses in the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies reflecting the several areas of study available there: Inquiry (INQU), Environmental Sustainability (ENSU), and, when they are approved by Senate, Criminology (CRIM), and Media Studies (MDST).

Rationale of the Proposed Calendar Change(s):
(Corresponding to Section 2 where required)

The designation "Inquiry" and code letter prefix "INQU" used for courses in the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies are relics that date back to 2006 when there were just two courses on the subject of inquiry but no department as such. Since then, the department has come into existence and has proposed other interdisciplinary courses and programs. In most other departments course codes match the name of the department in which they are offered. In multi-disciplinary departments, though, multiple course codes exist; e.g., in the Department of Languages, French courses are distinguished from German courses, Italian courses, etc. We are not a Department of Inquiry -- rather, we are a Department of Interdisciplinary Studies.
