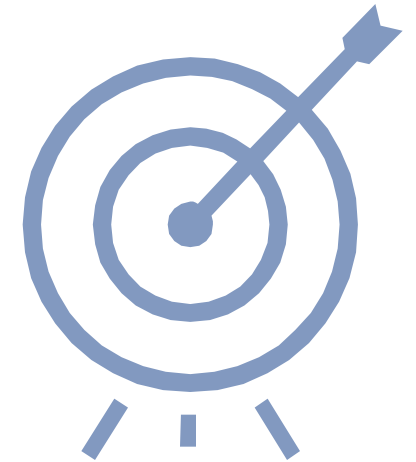

- The TGMS business outcomes are:
 - Increased internal and external user/stakeholder satisfaction;
 - Increased organizational effectiveness across and within agencies; and
 - Increased flexibility and responsiveness to meet new or changing Government of Canada and agency priorities

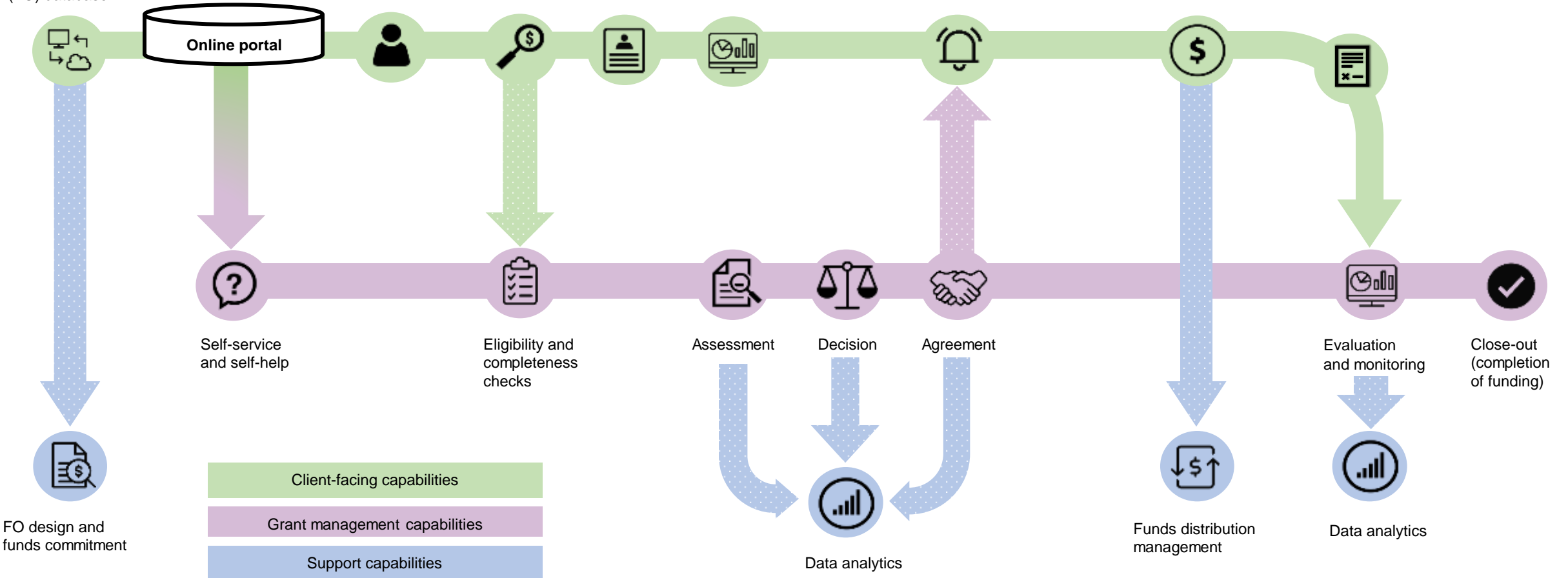

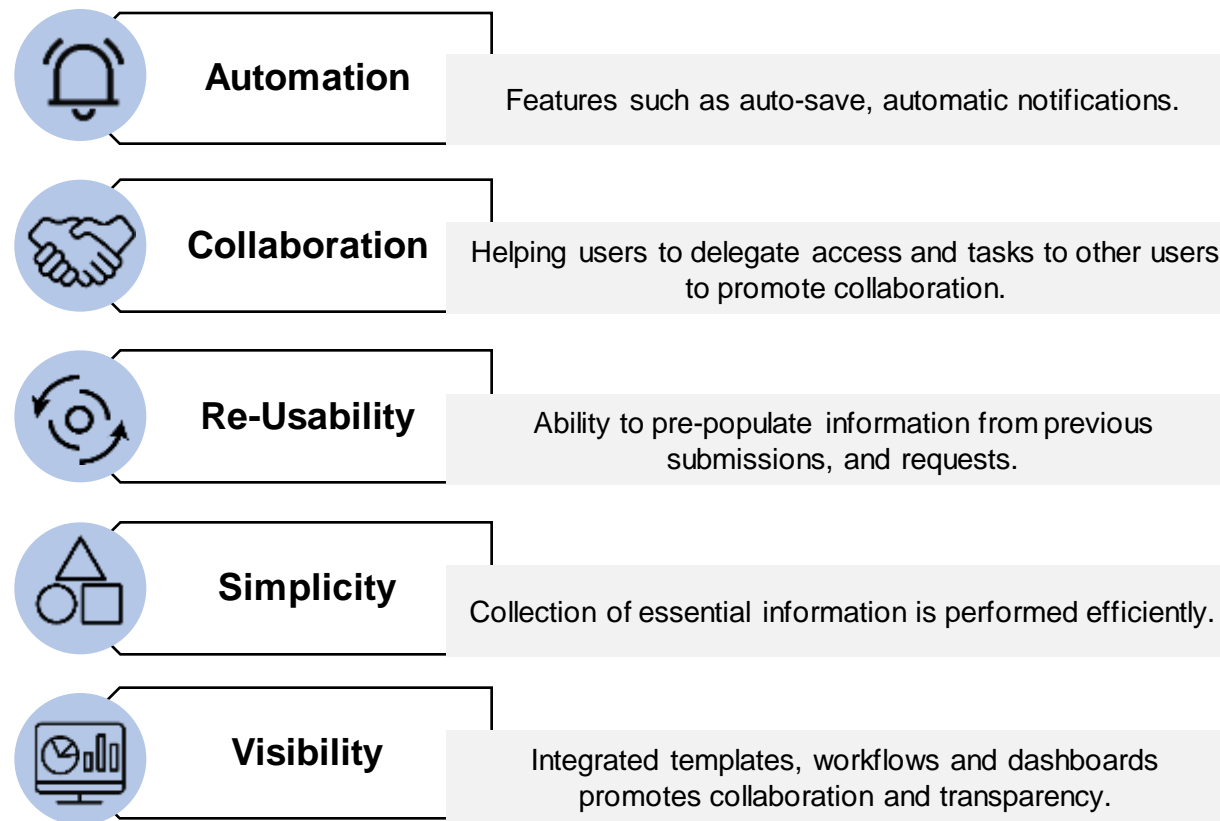

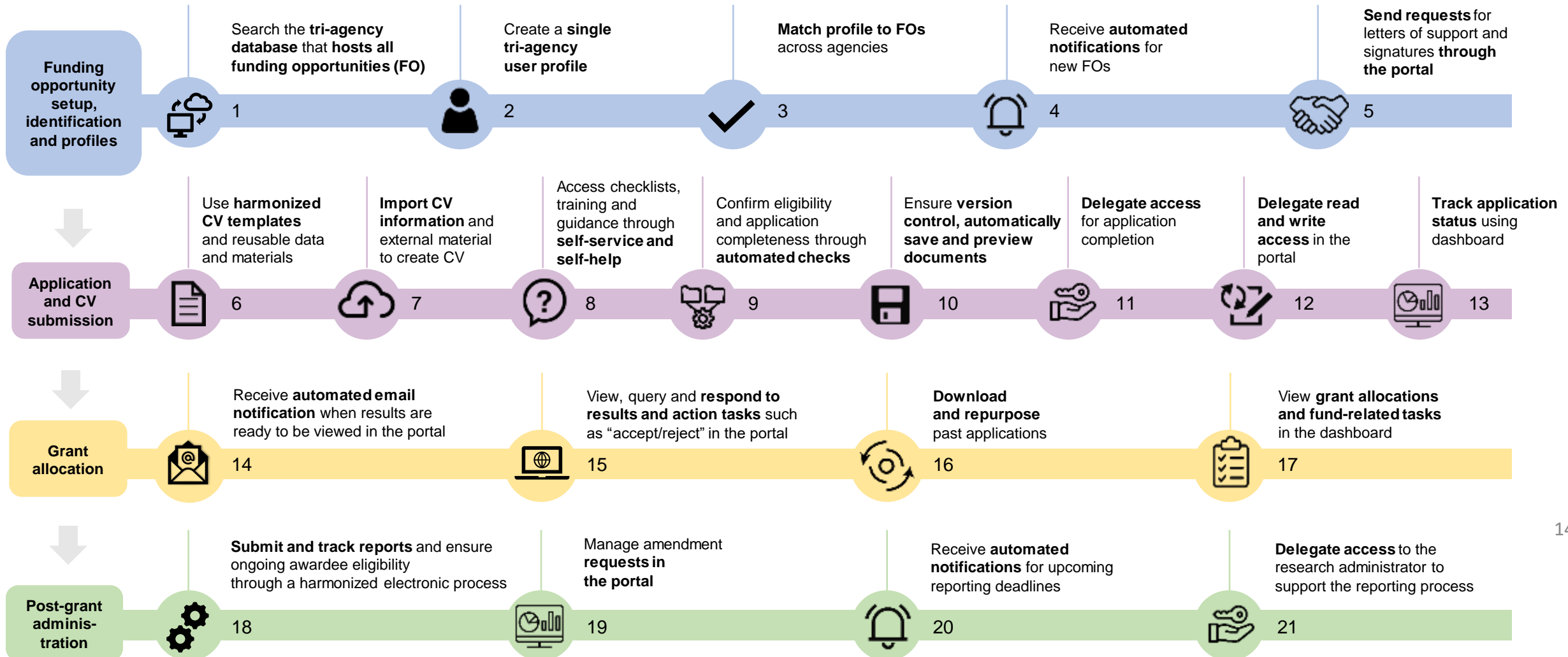

Top opportunities for the TGMS initiative

External participants:

1. Harmonize and streamline the processes across the three Agencies.
2. Provide one single solution with one portal for all user roles with the ability to share tasks and data.
3. Ensure that the new solution is easy to use and that it is not only user-centric but more specifically, designed for grants management of research funding.

“The new solution needs to be a single solution, with a single interface for all users. It must reduce the administrative burden, provide visibility throughout the life cycle of a competition and enable consistent and logical dissemination of results.”
