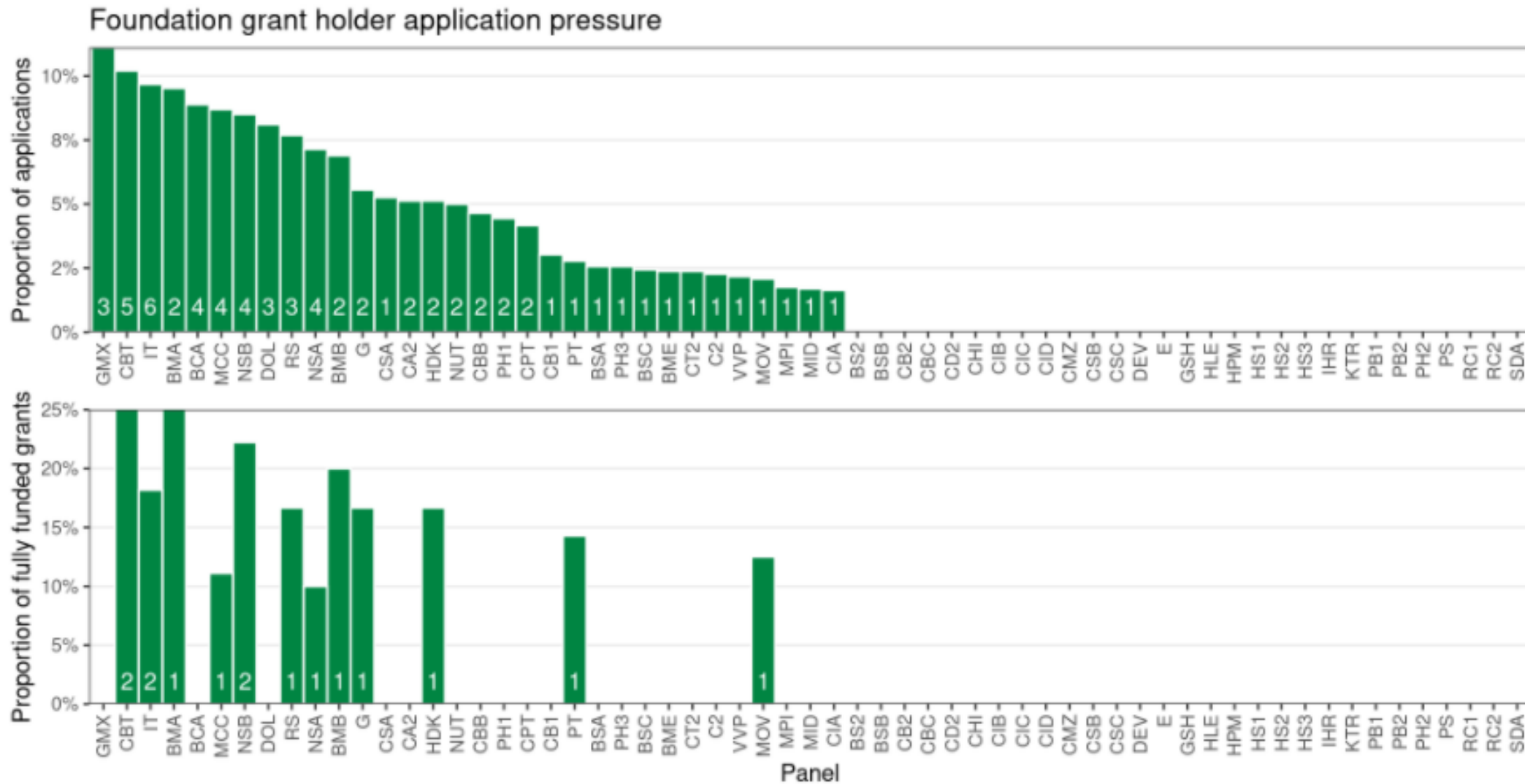
FDN Grant Holders

7 The white numbers on the bars in the count of FDN applications/grants

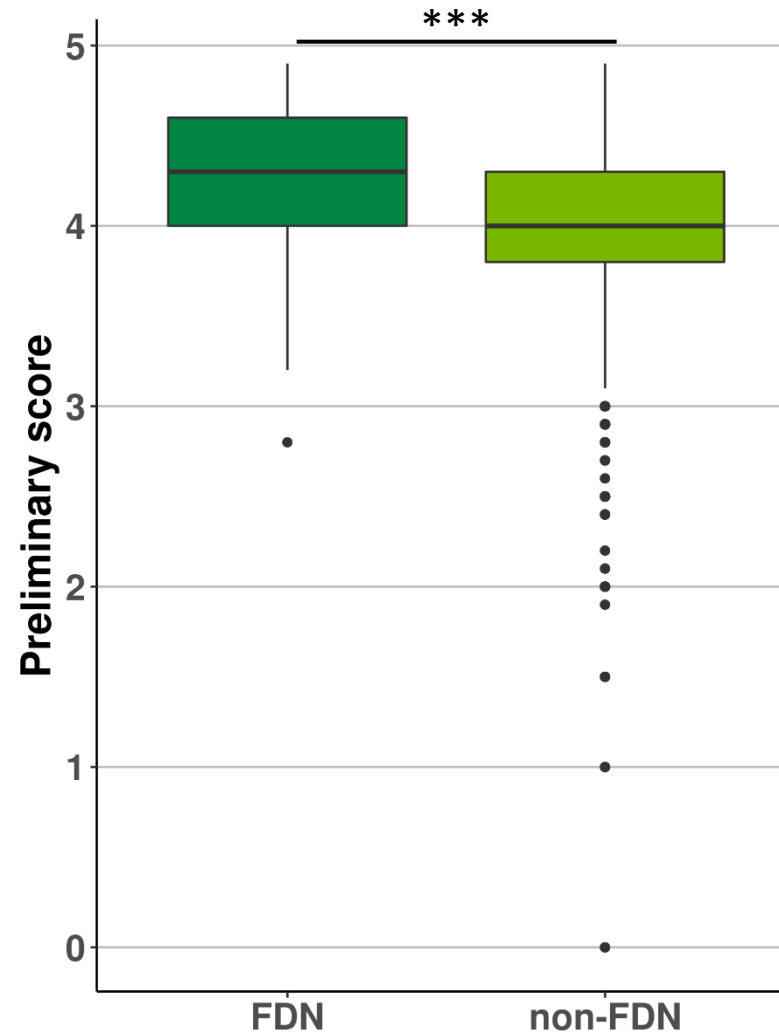
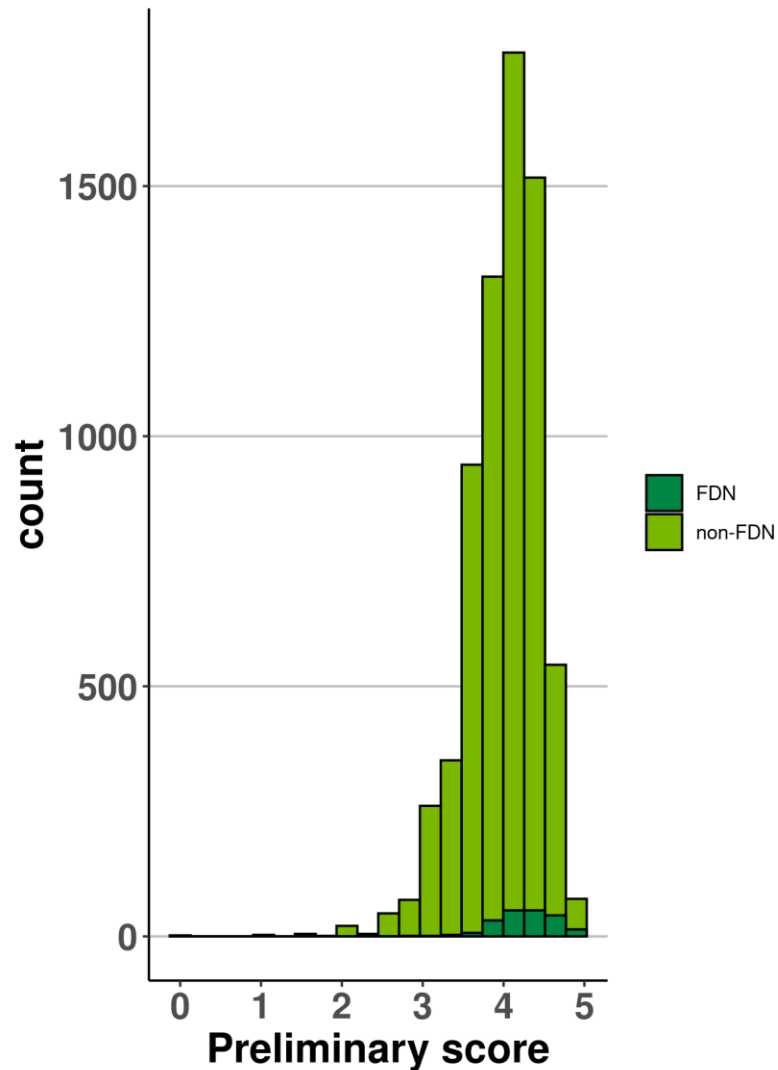
Voting behavior for FDN grantees

Was there a bias for/against FDN grantees in the 202104PJT competition

- In the 202104PJT competition, there were 68 applications from 53 FDN grantees. 15 applications from 15 FDN grantees were successful.
- Analyzed 4 different scores in the review process:
 - i. Preliminary scores
 - ii. Consensus scores
 - iii. Votes
 - iv. Final scores
- Included the following as a follow-up analysis
 - v. Percent rank
- All statistical analyses compared FDN grantees to non-FDN grantees. Note that the equal and disproportionate sample sizes necessitated the use of non-parametric statistical tests

Voting behavior for FDN grantees

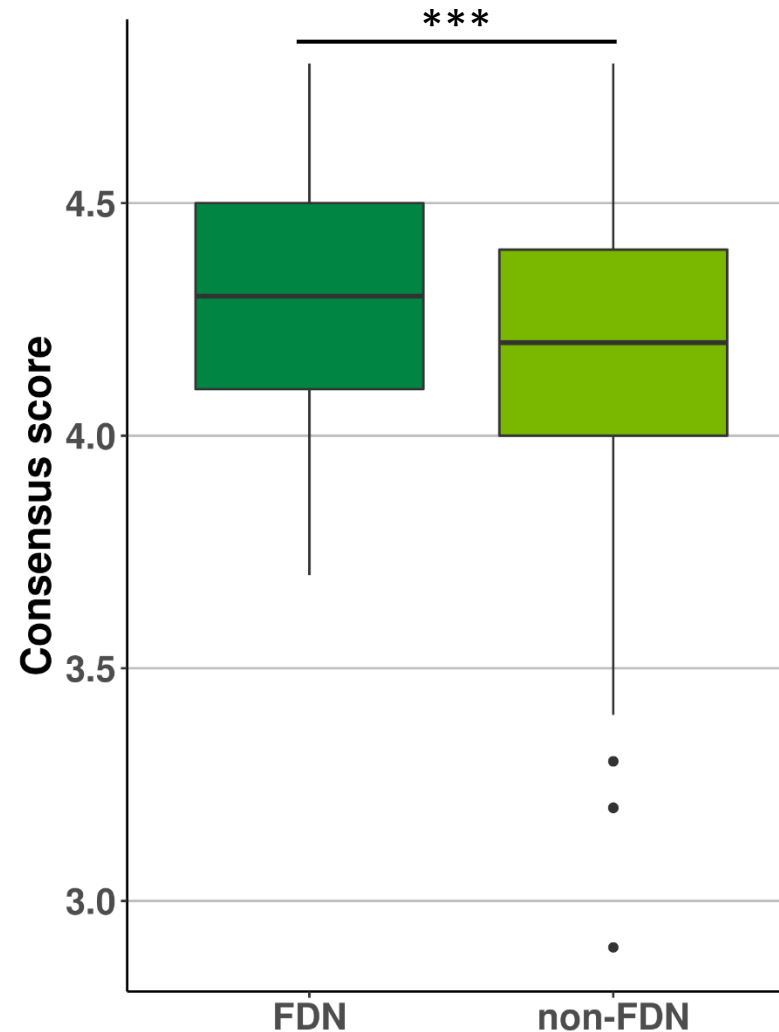
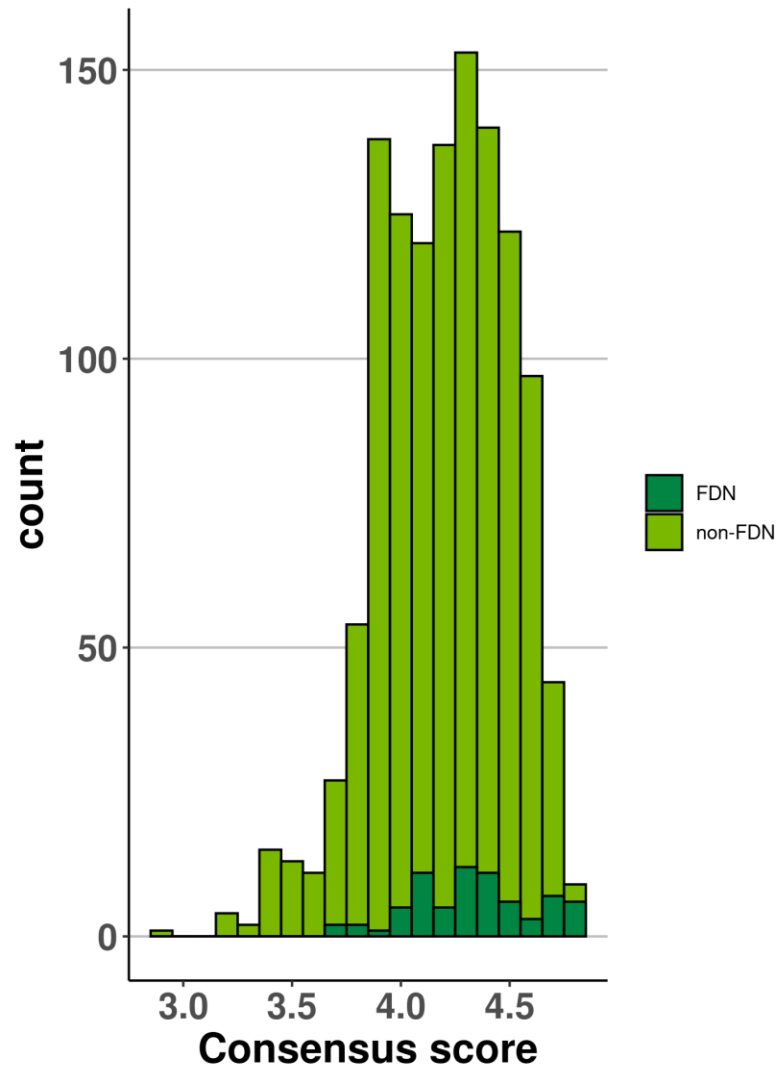
i. Preliminary scores



Applications from FDN holders received significantly higher preliminary scores ($p < 0.001$)

ii. Consensus scores

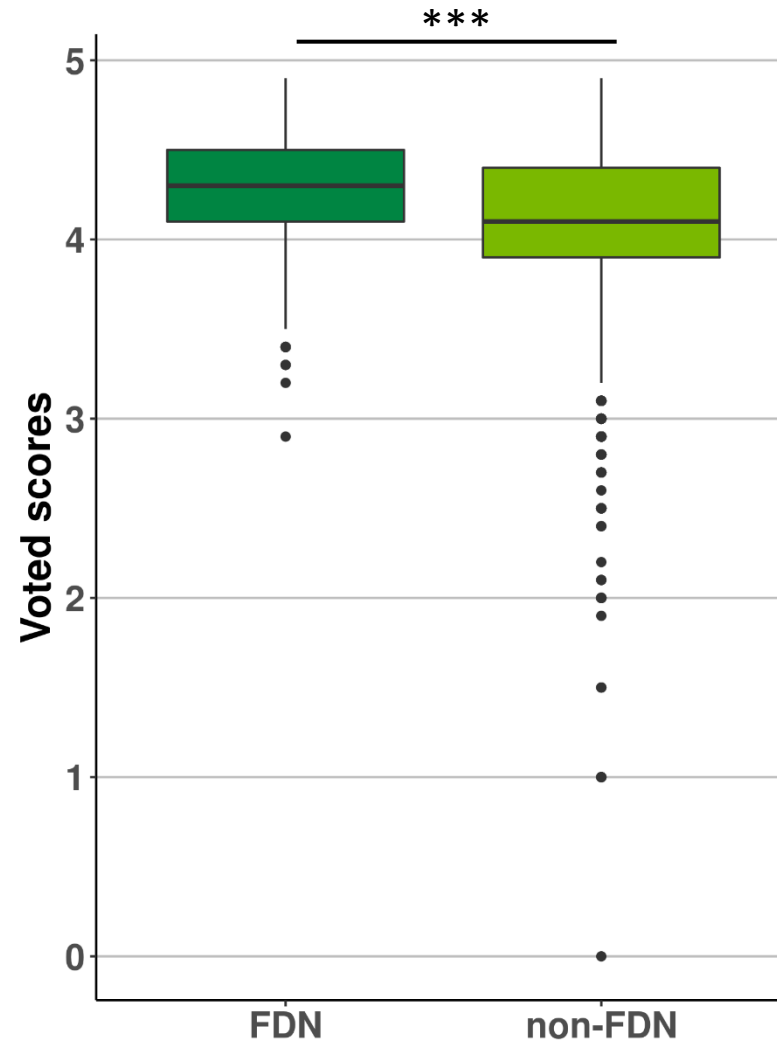
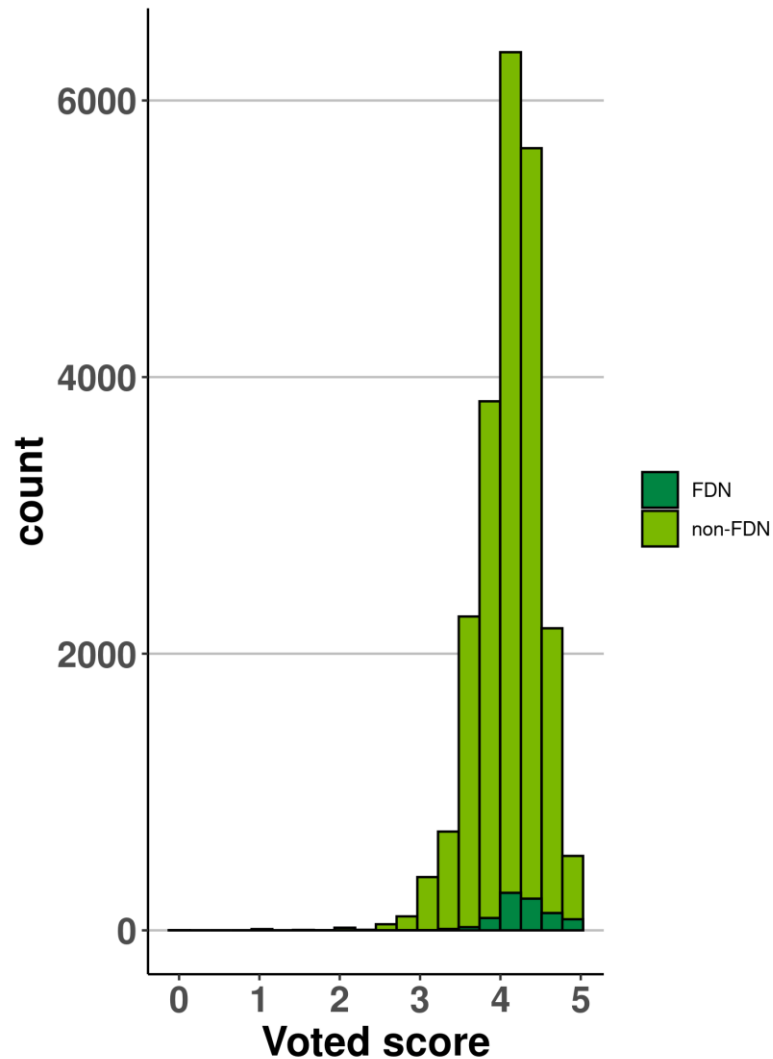


Applications from FDN holders received significantly higher consensus scores ($p < 0.001$)

Voting behavior for FDN grantees

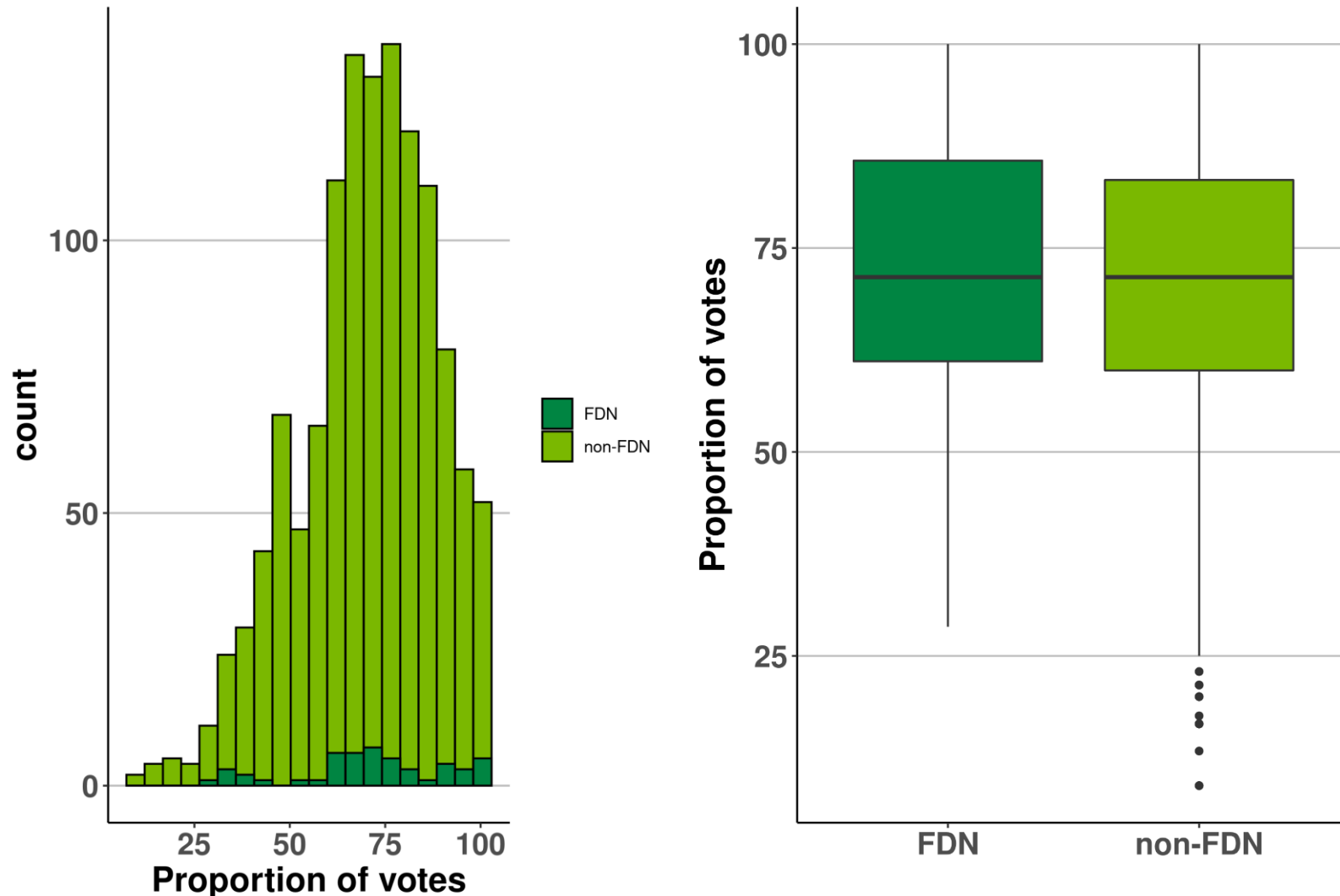
iii. Vote - Scores

iii. Vote – Proportion of votes

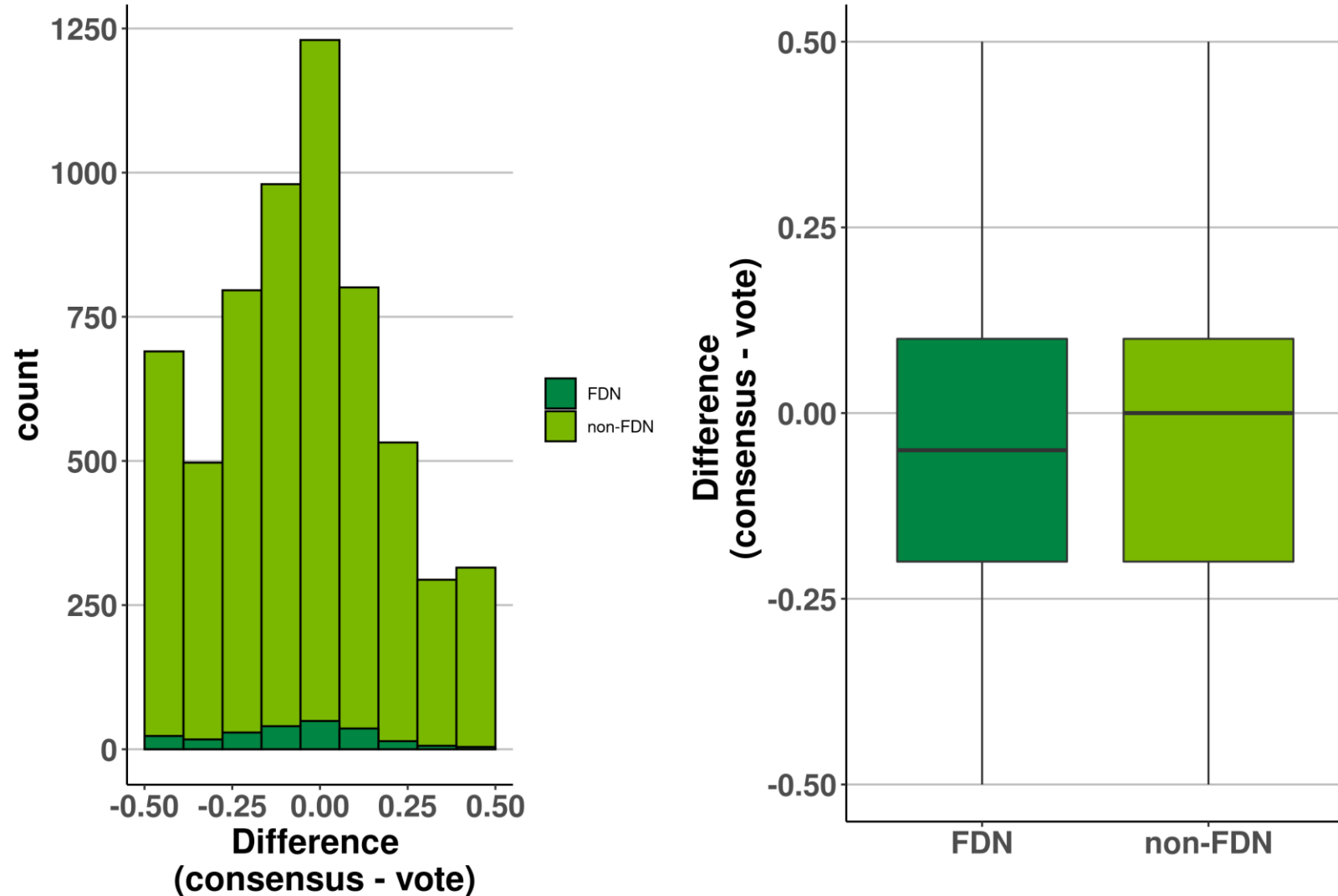


Applications from FDN holders did not receive a significantly higher proportion of votes (i.e., individual scores > than the consensus)

Note: applications that did not receive a consensus score were not included in this analysis

iii. Vote – Difference from consensus score

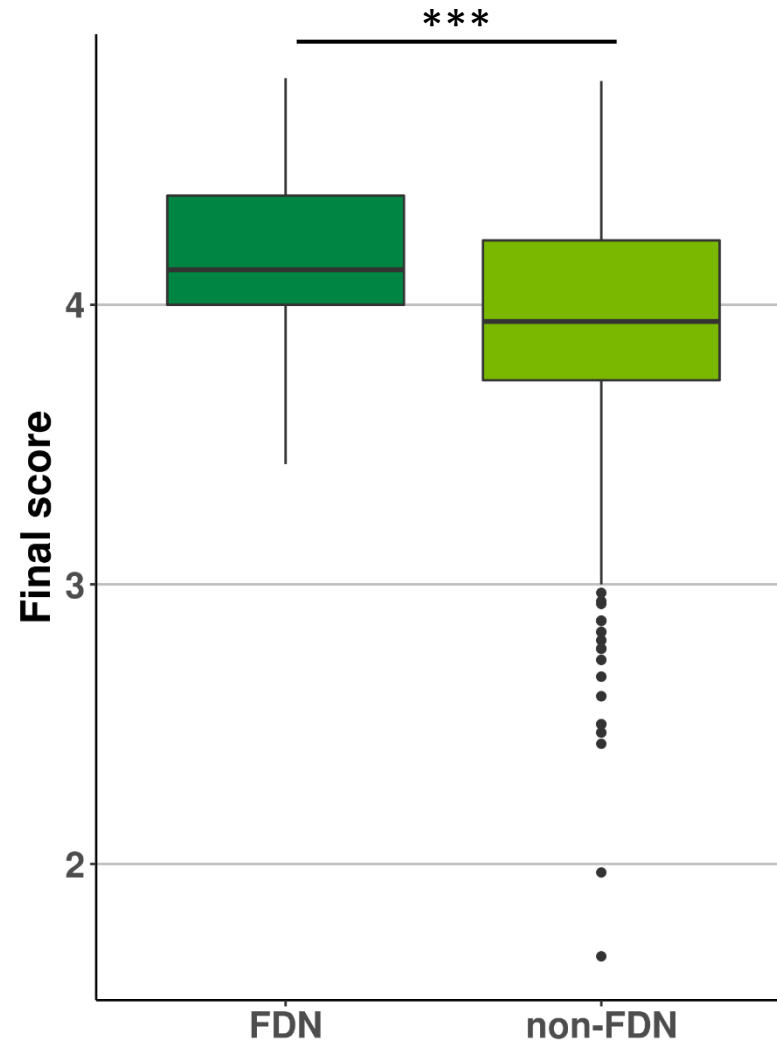
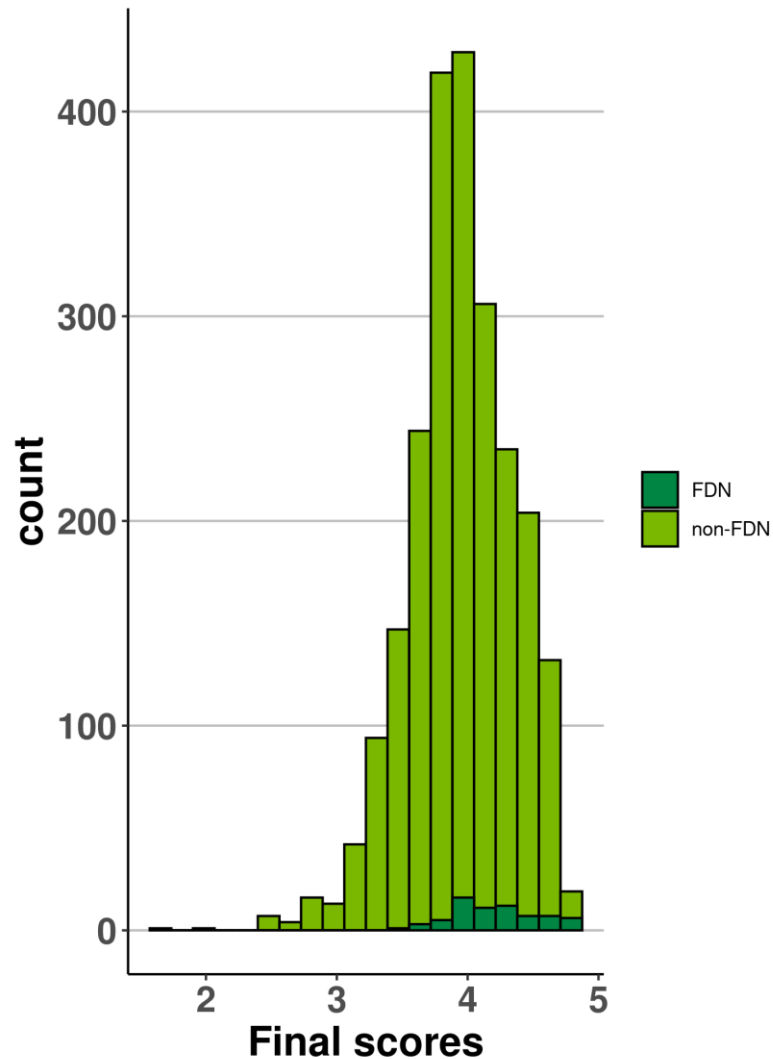


The difference between the consensus and voted scores was not different for applications from FDN holders ($p > 0.05$)

Voting behavior for FDN grantees

iv. Final scores



Applications from FDN holders received significantly higher final scores ($p < 0.01$)

Voting behavior for FDN grantees

Summary

- FDN grant holders received:
 - **Higher** preliminary scores
 - **Higher** consensus scores
 - **Higher** voted scores
 - **The same** proportion of votes
 - **The same** difference between the consensus and voted scores
 - **Higher** final scores

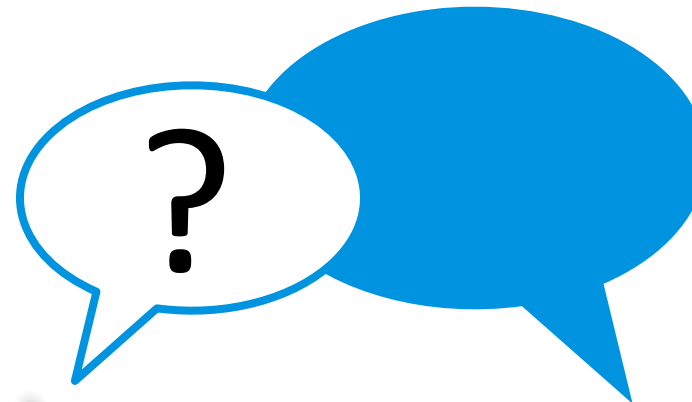

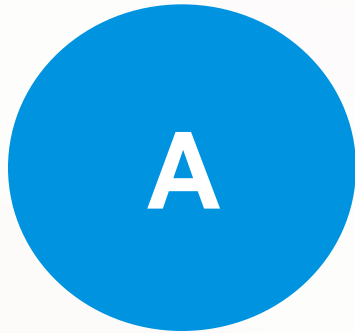

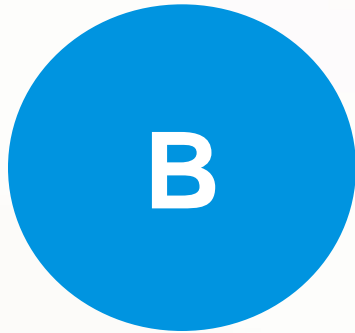
