A Supervisory Officer is a Director, Superintendent, or assistant superintendent of a District School Board (not a School Principal). The teaching experience must have been completed for one of the following: a school board, a private school, Indian and Northern Affairs Canada, a council of a band, or education authority of a band. Experience at a University or a Community College is not recognized.

Note: For applicants whose teaching experience has been with a First Nation Education Authority or private school, the Ontario College of Teachers requires this form to be signed by a Supervisory Officer from the Ontario Ministry of Education.
