The Interdisciplinary Studies (Arts and Science) program encourages you to think beyond the isolated disciplinary structures, trains you in multidisciplinary critical thinking skills and problem-solving strategies, and prepares you for a rich variety of post-graduate possibilities.

Our Interdisciplinary Studies program is flexible in its design, allowing you to customize your educational experience.

The Bachelor of Arts and Science (Interdisciplinary Studies) program is designed for college transfer students who wish to complete their degree in one year. The Honours Bachelor of Arts and Science (Interdisciplinary Studies) program is designed for those students who wish to invest in an additional year of education, and can meet the demanding regimen of an honours program. The honours program can normally be completed in two years.

General Admission Requirements

Graduates from any 2-year diploma program in General Arts and Science or Liberal Arts from an Ontario college, with a minimum average of 70%, may be considered for admission into the third year of the Bachelor of Arts and Science (Interdisciplinary Studies Major), or into the third year of the Honours Bachelor of Arts and Science (Interdisciplinary Studies Major).

Bachelor of Arts and Science (BASc) (Interdisciplinary Studies Major)

All applicants will need to complete a certain number of specific courses from a variety of subject areas in their college program. These courses include:

- at least two (2) one-semester courses of: math, science, geography, or introductory psychology;
- at least one (1) one-semester course in: Inquiry methods or Senior Academic Research;
- at least two (2) one-semester college courses of advanced academic content; and
- at least two (2) introductory one-semester college courses in one (1) of the following areas: Anthropology, Biology, English Literature, Geography, General Science, History, Political Science, Psychology, and Sociology.

Honours Bachelor of Arts and Science (HBASc) (Interdisciplinary Studies Major)

All applicants will need to complete a certain number of specific courses from a variety of subject areas in their college program. The required courses are:

- at least two (2) one-semester courses of: math, science, geography, or introductory psychology;
- at least one (1) one-semester course in: Inquiry methods or Senior Academic Research;
- at least two (2) one-semester college courses of advanced academic content; and
- at least two (2) introductory one-semester college courses in two (2) of the following areas: Anthropology, Biology, English Literature, Geography, General Science, History, Political Science, Psychology, and Sociology.
